



Program Objective

The Falkirk Mining Company has established a sponsorship with North Dakota State College of Science "NDSCS" in Wahpeton, ND to financially assist students who plan to continue their education in the field of study within Diesel Mechanics or Electrical. The program's mission is to provide a work-study paid internship for graduating high school seniors pursuing a career within the mining industry in a field of study listed above. This program allows students to gain hands-on education while pursuing their degree.

This sponsorship program is solely administered by The Falkirk Mining Company. Recipient awards are granted without regard to race, color, religion or creed, sex, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, age, disability, national origin or ancestry, or military or veteran.

Eligibility

Applicants for the Program must meet the following criteria for consideration:

- High School GPA of 2.75 or greater
- ACT Score of 15 or greater
- Planning to pursue or already pursuing a career in Diesel Mechanics or Electrical at NDSCS for the upcoming academic year.
 - Must show proof of acceptance into NDSCS

Awards

If selected as an awarded recipient, the student may receive a portion or all of the following:

First Academic Year:

- 50% tuition, to exclude room & board
- 50% fees over and above tuition, to include books
- 50% required basic tools, to include computer and necessary software if applicable for field of study
- 50% required basic toolbox, if applicable for field of study
- 100% uniforms, if applicable

Second Academic Year:

- 100% tuition, to exclude room & board
- 100% fees over and above tuition, to include books
- 100% required tools, if required for field of study
- 100% uniforms, if applicable

Program Requirements

Awarded recipient(s) must remain in satisfactory academic performance in a full-time course of study with at least a 2.75 GPA while attending NDSCS.

After each complete semester, the student must attach and submit a college transcript directly to the Falkirk Mining Company's Human Resources Department within two weeks of the completed semester.
