

22-23 NJSLA Highlights

- ★ IHGS scored above state averages in ALL subject areas again.
- ★ All classes that have taken NJSLA more than one time (current 5th, 6th, 7th) have shown growth & increased in Math and ELA from the previous year, except current 6th in Math.
- ★ 22-23 5th Grade Science (Current 6th) scores are improving each year and higher than 18-19 scores!
- 4th Grade (Current 5th) ELA Scores were very high, with 91.7% Meeting or Exceeding Expectations
- ★ 22-23 4th Grade (Current 5th) ELA & Math and 22-23 6th Grade (Current 7th) Math exceeded the 18-19 test scores.



Moving Forward

- ★ We will continue to use this data to monitor growth and drive instruction in our classrooms. Focus on moving students with 3's to a 4 or 5.
- ★ Provide PD opportunities for teachers. NWEA MAP & Special Education. Analyze & discuss data at staff meetings.
- ★ W.I.N. Periods: Teachers use these periods to address individual/classroom needs. (Math Fluency, Word Problems & Strategies, Writing Support, Phonics, Comprehension, etc.)
- ★ Pathblazer: Online program linked to MAP scores to provide students with an individualized learning path based on their needs.
- ★ STARS (Basic Skills): Students that scored a 1, 2, or 3 and do not receive special education are eligible for basic skills.
 - Continue our NJSLA morning test prep that were restarted during the 22-23 school year.
 - NJ DOE High Impact Tutoring Grant: Targeting Grades 3 & 4
 - 4th Grade: In kindergarten at the start of the pandemic. Looking to increase STARS periods in the schedule. Restructuring classroom ELA lessons to allot more time for individual support. Additional instructional support during daily ELA blocks.
