### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Parents are a child's first and most enduring teachers! ECFE classes are designed for you and your children ages birth through kindergarten entry. Join us for an engaging, fun-filled learning experience!

#### **Mixed Ages** (6 months – 5 years)

A broad range of ages and developmental stages are present in this group. Parents may attend with one or more of their children. Activities include free • Limited numbers for safety and enjoyment of all play, stories, sensory materials, art, and snack time. • Do not bring children who are ill Group time includes music, movement, finger plays, and books.
