Academy Transition Plan: How We Plan to Prepare Your Student to Choose an Academy



You may have heard some buzz about the Academies of Shakopee! If you haven't, the Academies of Shakopee are small learning communities organized by area of interest that open in the Fall of 2018.

In total, there are 7 Academies: Arts & Communication, Business & Entrepreneurship, Engineering & Manufacturing, Health Science, Human Services, Science & Technology, and the Freshman Academy.















These areas of interest are not new to students at West Junior High! The past three years, our students have registered for elective courses that are categorized according to these interest areas. In addition, the career lessons in both 7th and 8th grade attempt to highlight connections between junior high electives, high school academies, and future college or career plans.

Next winter, the graduating classes of 2021, 2020, and 2019 will be asked to choose an Academy based on their interests. With exciting changes and big decisions on the horizon, the Counseling Department has developed a plan to help students and families prepare to choose the Academy that best fits each student's interests and future goals. At the end of this newsletter, you will see a detailed plan of what we already are doing, what we plan to add next year, and our long-term plan to help students be college and career ready.

Classroom Lessons

Ms. Gerster and Mrs. Richter were in 9th grade English classrooms helping students develop their first resume.

During the lesson, students reflected on their academic, work and volunteer experiences before entering their information into a resume builder on Naviance: Family Connection. Students will have access to their saved resume, as well as the resume builder, all throughout high school. This might be useful later on when applying to colleges and careers; some students already used theirs to obtain summer jobs!

Connect to College & Career

As usual, we had a lot of fun implementing Connect to College & Career lessons and lunch activities this spring!

February: Career Connections Game

Students were challenged to make connections between various careers, college majors, and salary amounts. They also had to identify which of the six Academies of Shakopee each career fell into.

March: College Athletics & Activities

Students completed an online scavenger hunt to find information about college athletics, student clubs, student government, Greek life, and studying abroad.

April: Accepted or Not?

GPS classes were given admission requirements for a specific college and a summary of three hypothetical students. GPS classes then got to decide if those students were ACCEPTED, WAITLISTED, or DENIED!

May: Roadmap to Graduation

Students were faced with hypothetical scenarios related to their future. Students then discovered the positive and negative outcomes of their decisions while playing a board game resembling The Game of Life!

Mindfulness Apps for Your Student This Summer



Stop, Breathe, & Think: This app encourages students to check in on how they are feeling physically, mentally, and emotionally and recommends guided meditations tailored to their current state. Fun features: "body scan" mediation, yoga and acupressure videos, and a meditation timer with calming soundscapes.



What's Up?: This app focuses on helping students identify and overcome negative thinking patterns. Fun features: "grounding" game, metaphors and positive quotes to assist with coping, and a "catastrophe scale" that may help your student put things into perspective when feeling overwhelmed.



Aura: This app sends students 3-minute meditations everyday aimed at helping them find peace, comfort, and confidence. Fun features: a gratitude journal, a list for daily goals, and "mindful moment" pop-up notifications to remind students to take breathing breaks throughout the day.
