If you want to use a delicate material like tin foil, line the backside with tape so that it does not rip.

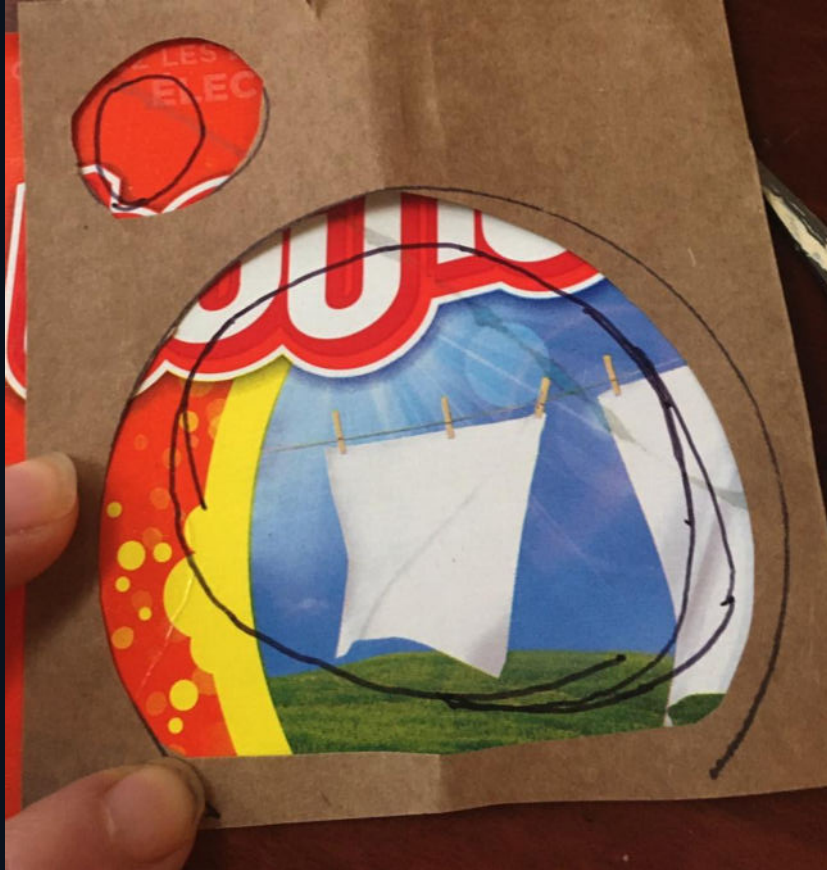




If you want exact shapes, use objects around the house as stencils.



If you want exact shapes, use objects around the house as stencils. To cut a circle into your paper, gently fold the paper in half and start in the middle as shown above.

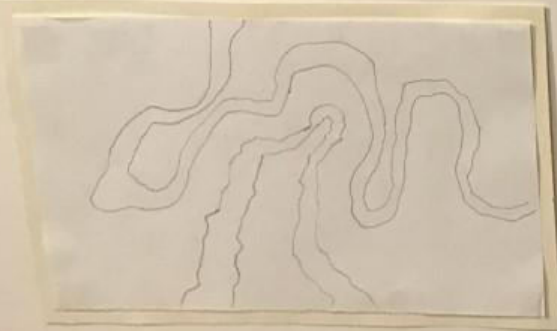
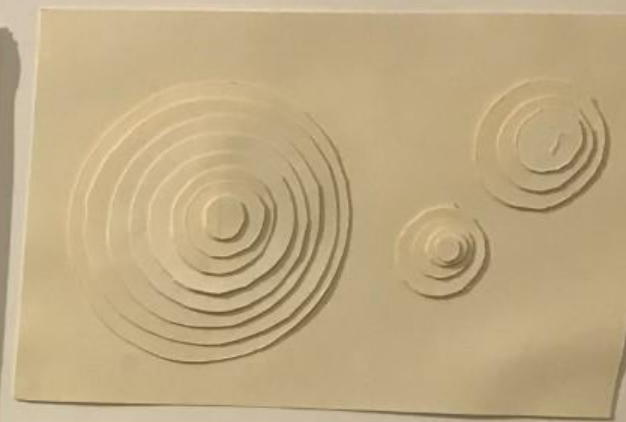
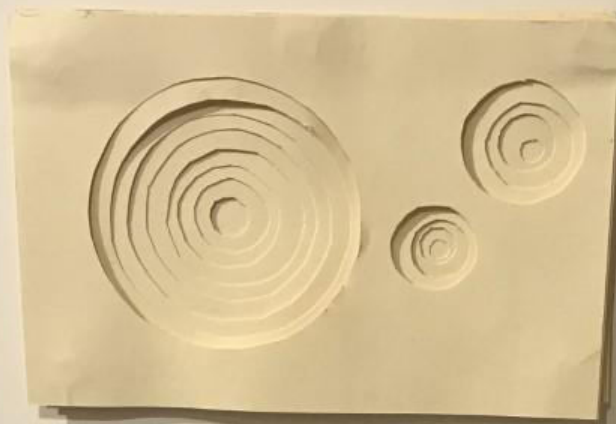
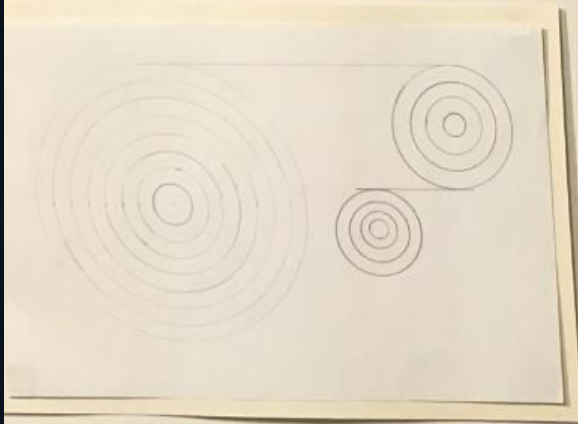


Start with the top layer, after you've cut your first layer use that to trace the following layer

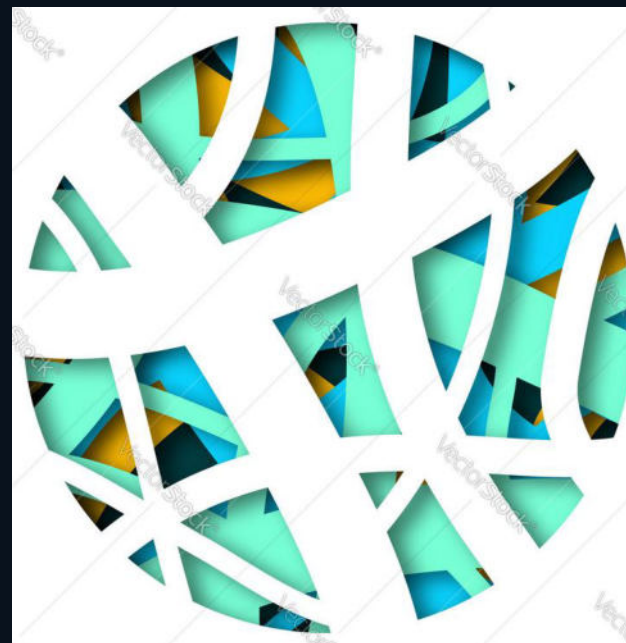
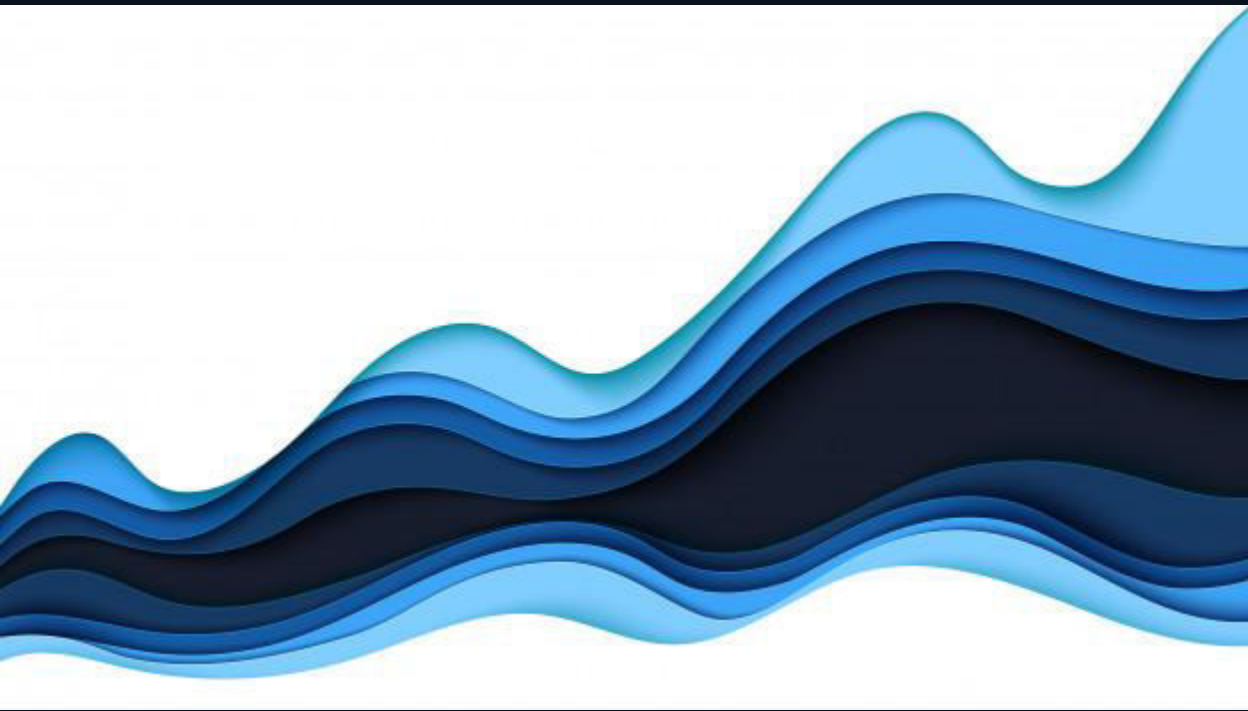
It's easier to use a pencil because you can erase the lines after, but if you may need to use a marker.

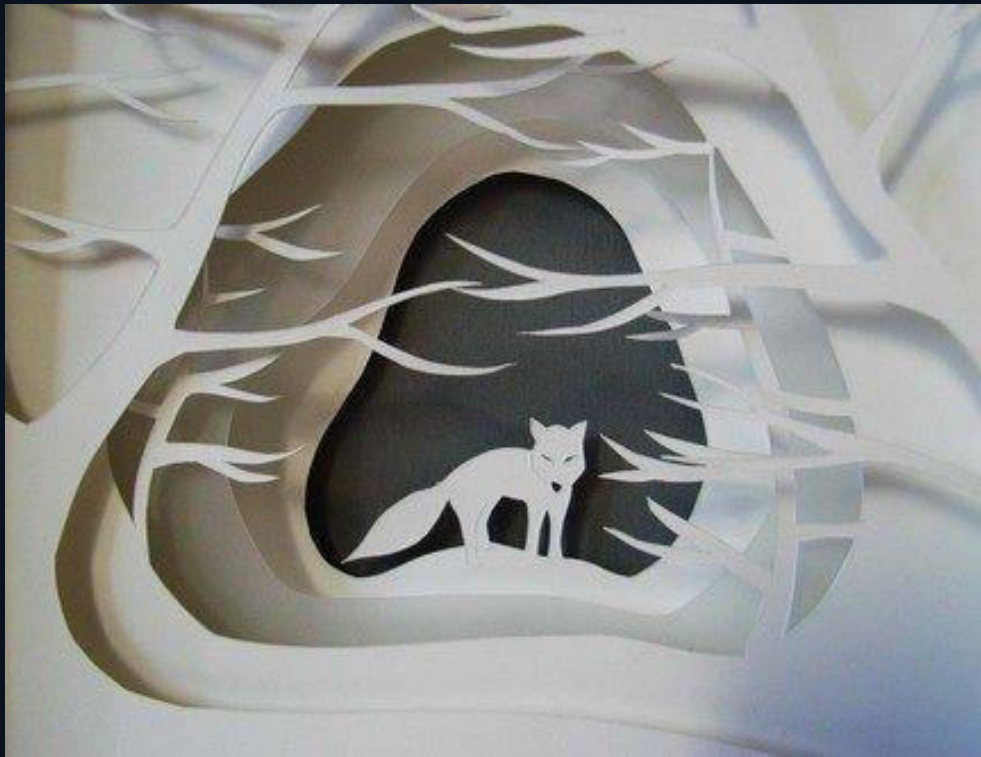
