Staple Cities is a quick project that will force you to revisit shooting techniques learned at the beginning of the semester.

1) Depth of Field (to be used in #1 of your portfolio) - try extreme apertures.

2) Equivalent exposures - possible use - #3, 4, 5 of your portfolio; need 3 photos that include effects of depth of field and shutter speed; exact same composition but all with different shutter speeds and apertures

Process for Staple Cities project:

- Supplies needed for shooting time: background = fabric, paper or screen, base = mirror or folder; light source = scotch tape colored with sharpies over your phone flashlight, bounce light as needed; buildings = staples; vantage point= very important to change your angle to make staples seem like buildings:
- Contact Sheet at least 10 shots with 2 different backgrounds; put these in a PDF and submit here.
- Crop and optimize your favorite image. Turn in your final jpg [name\_stapleCity.jpg] and only a screenshot of your layers list on the next assignment.
