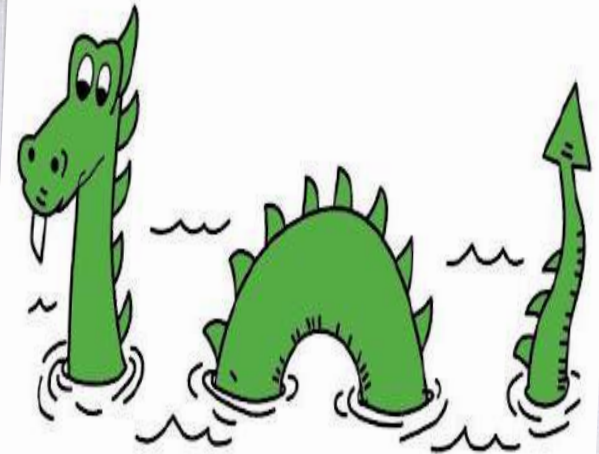

(Ex. 4th Grade was tested on 3rd Grade Standards.)
- x Administered to help identify the level of support needed for students.
- x Administered quickly (45-60 minutes), in person, with immediate results.
- x No open ended questions (writing prompts, etc.)




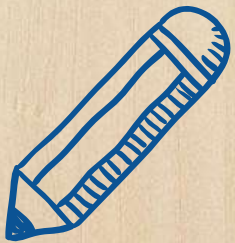

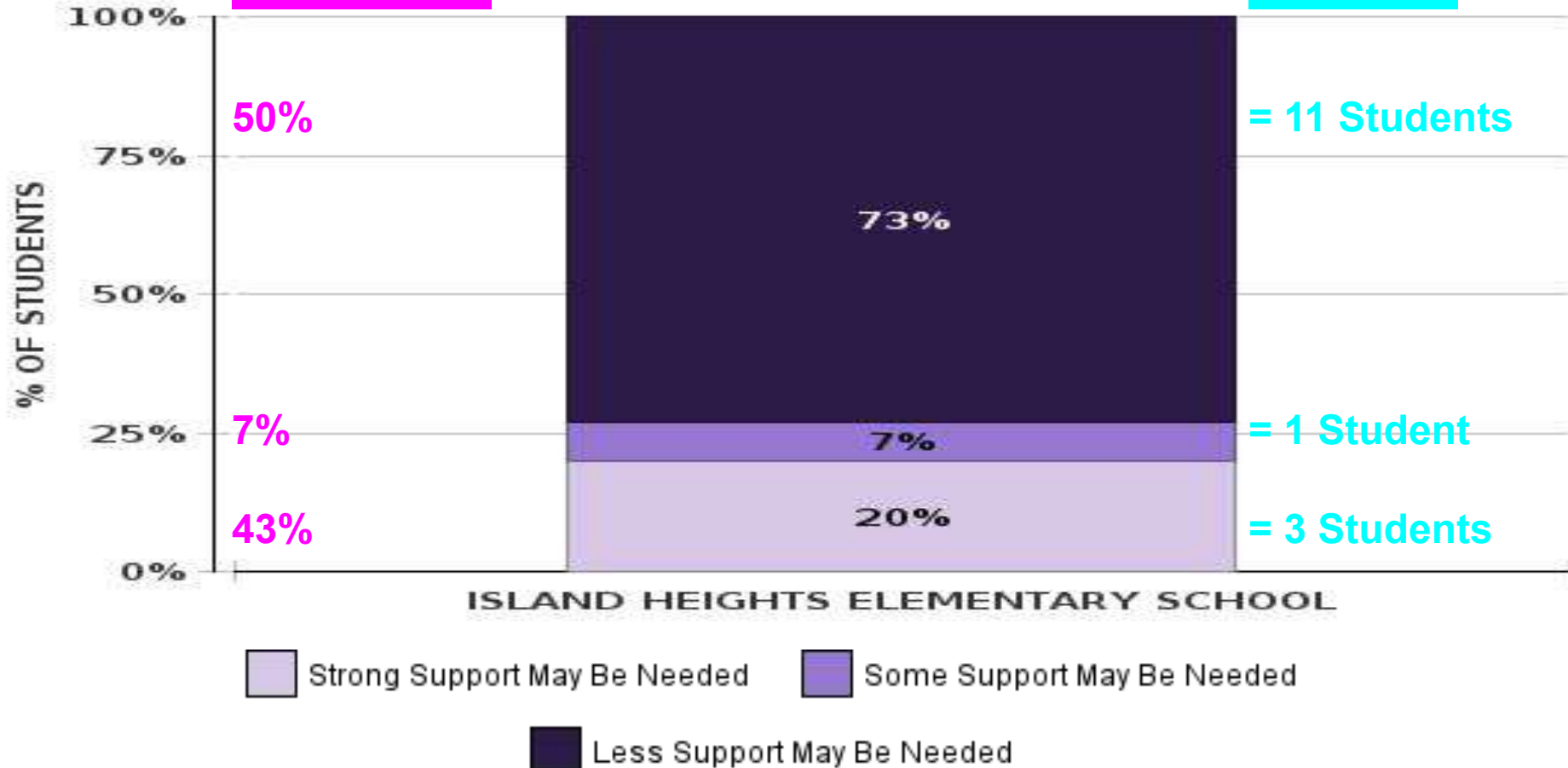

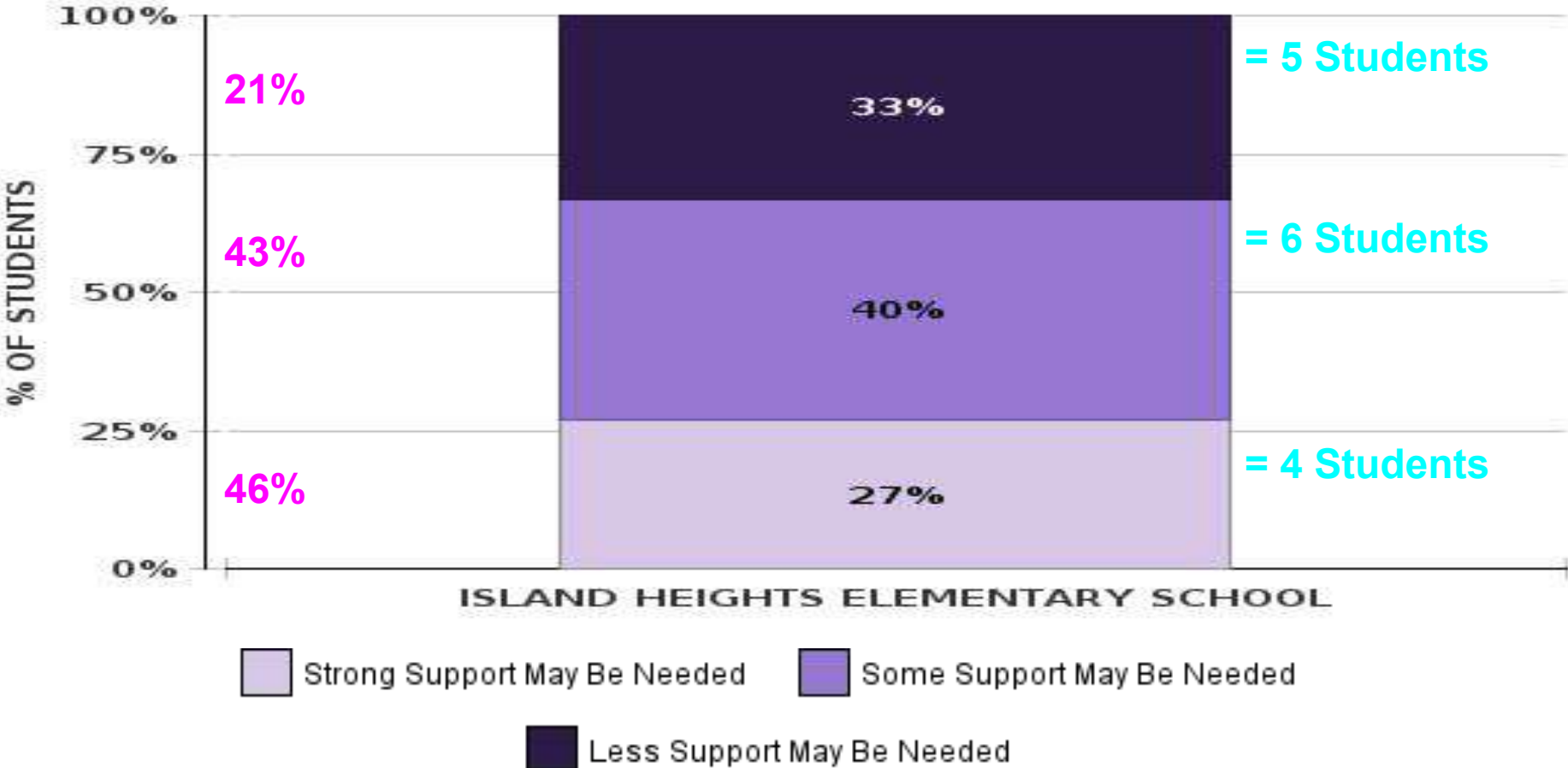

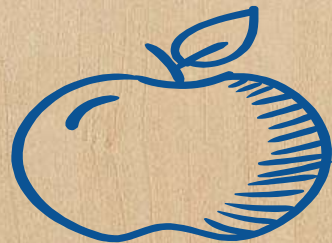

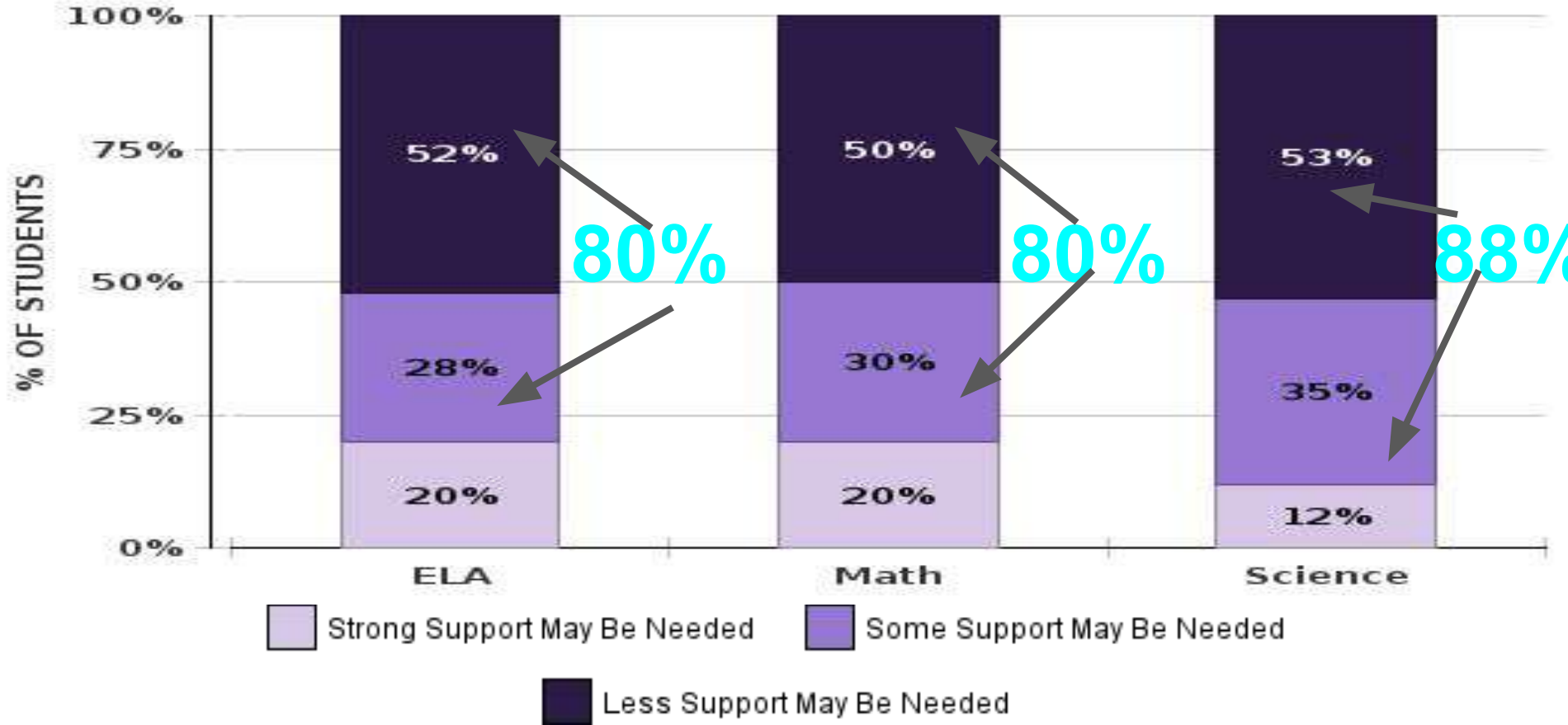




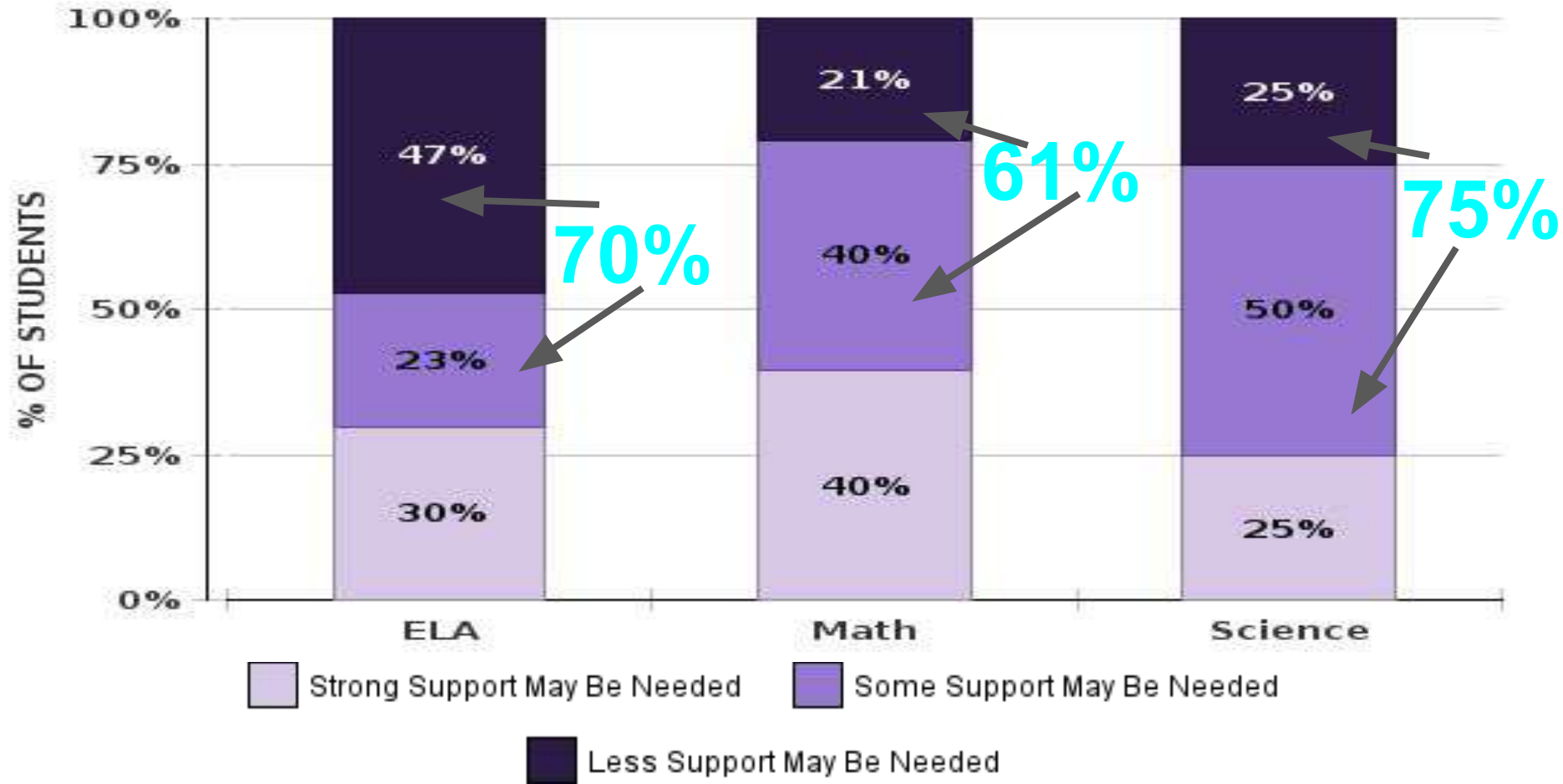
