(n.) Something that a person is expected to do



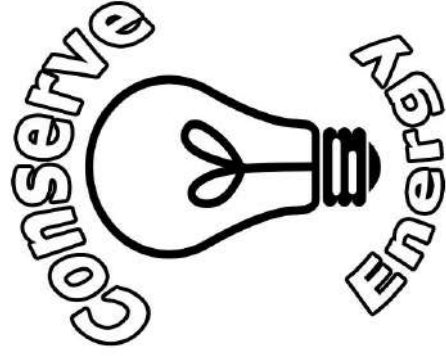

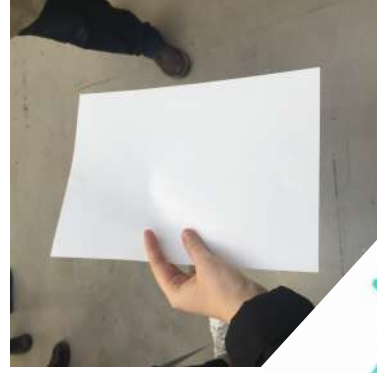

(v.) to save or protect something

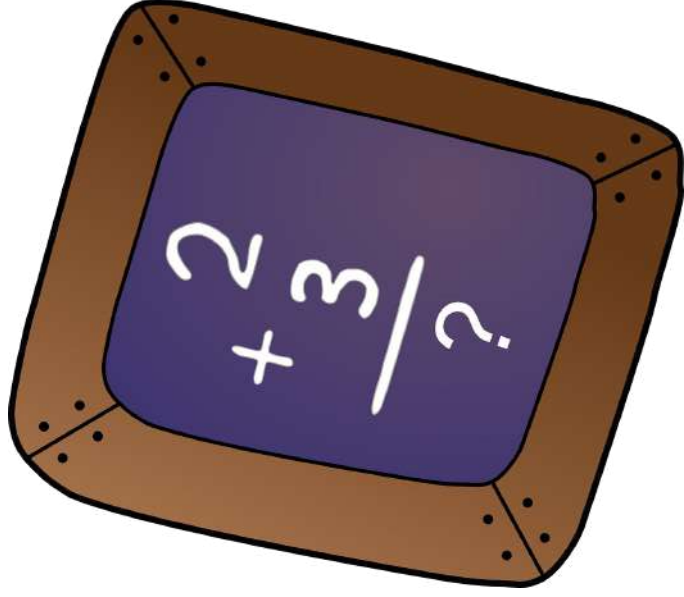

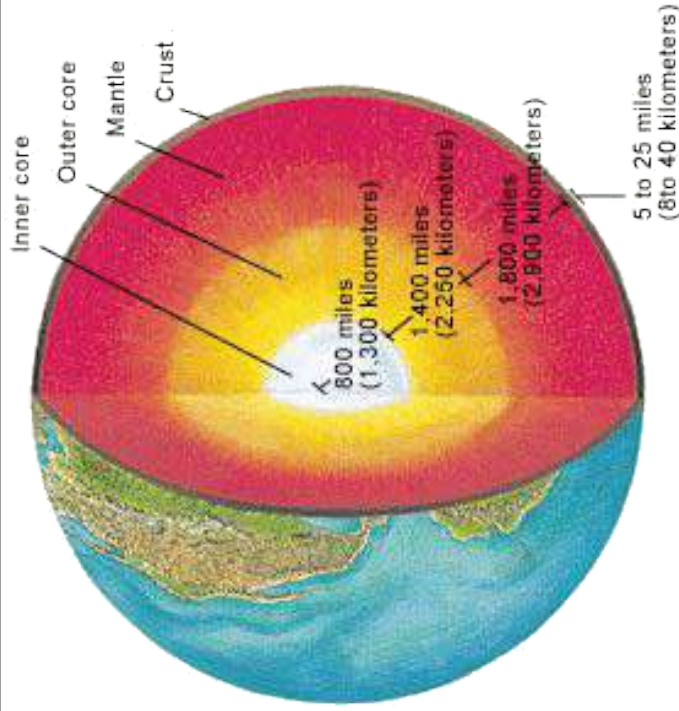
(n.) a try at something especially when it is hard

(n.) a place where garbage is dumped and buried



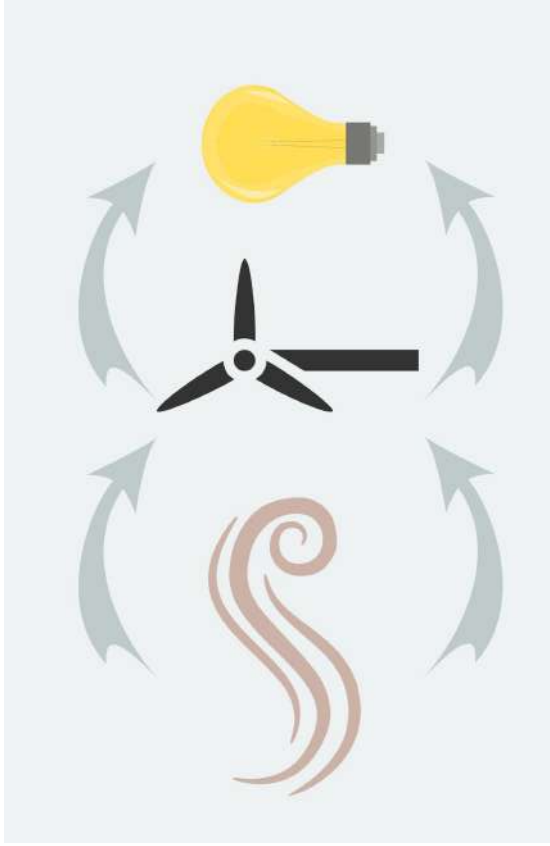

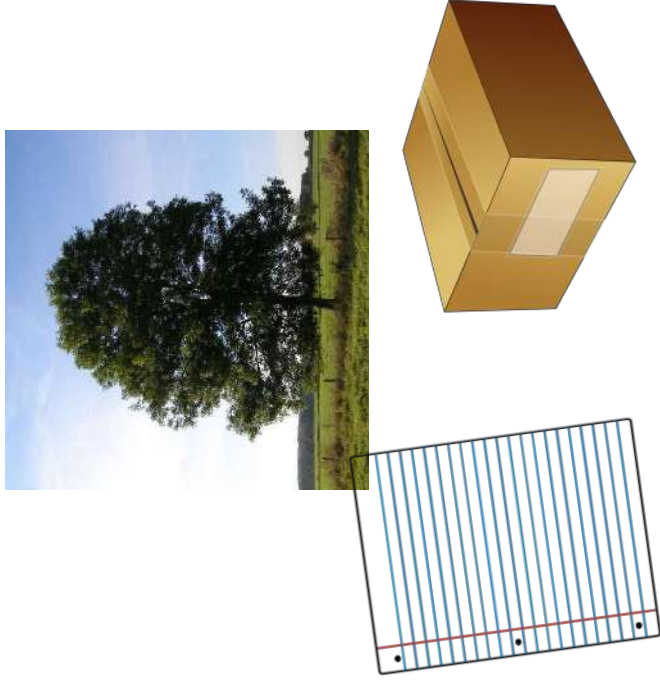
(v.) to make or create

aluminum

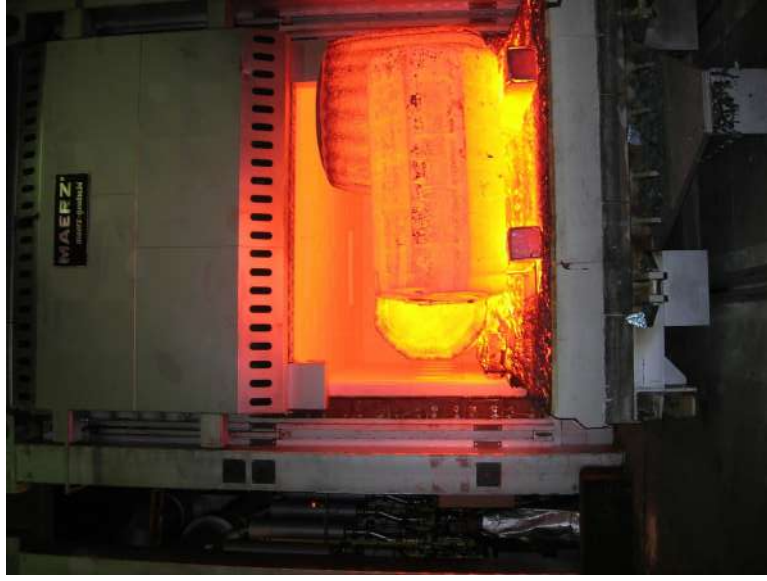
(n.) a type of metal used to make cans, foil, etc

nutrients

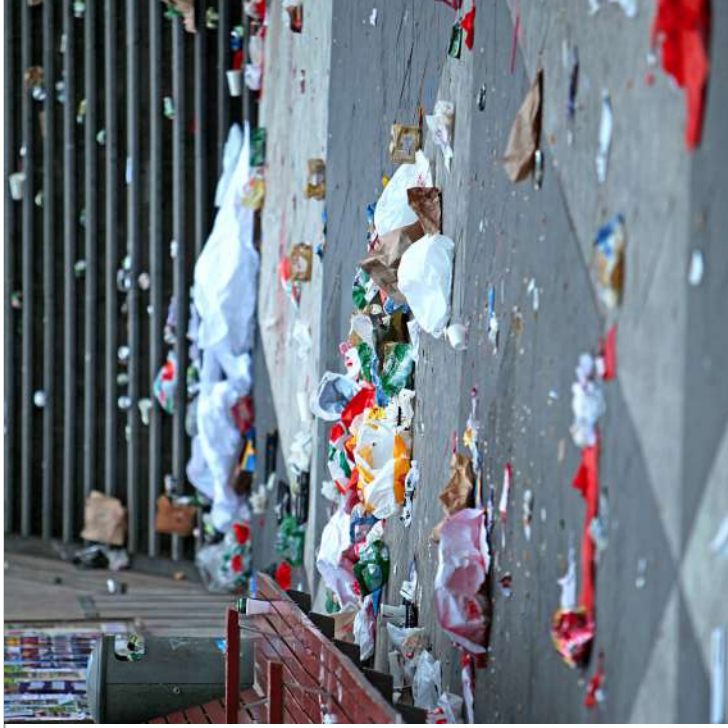
(n.) things needed by living things to grow and stay healthy, such as vitamins and minerals

exhaust

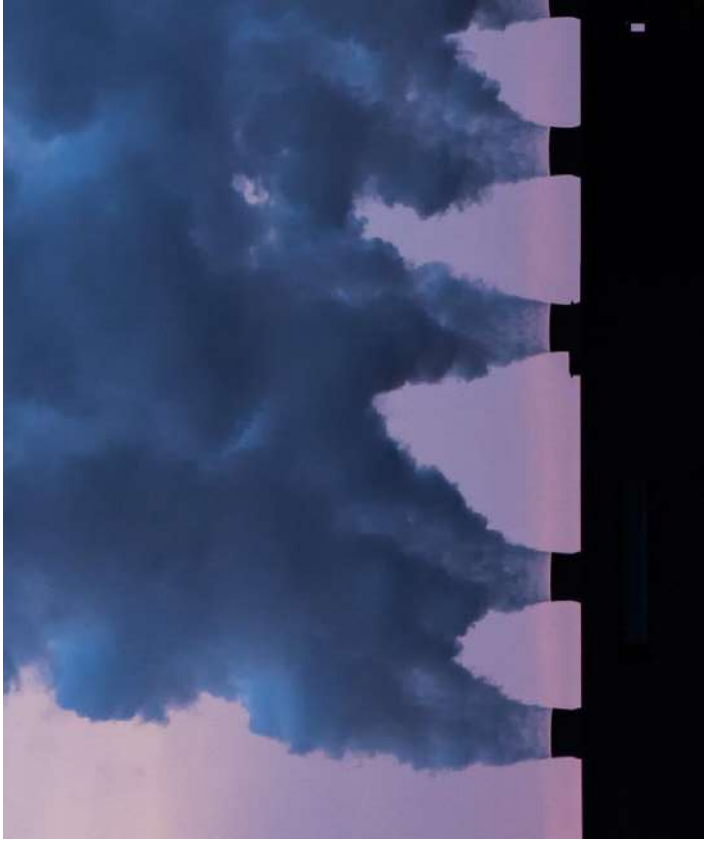
(n.) the waste that goes into the air from cars and other machines
