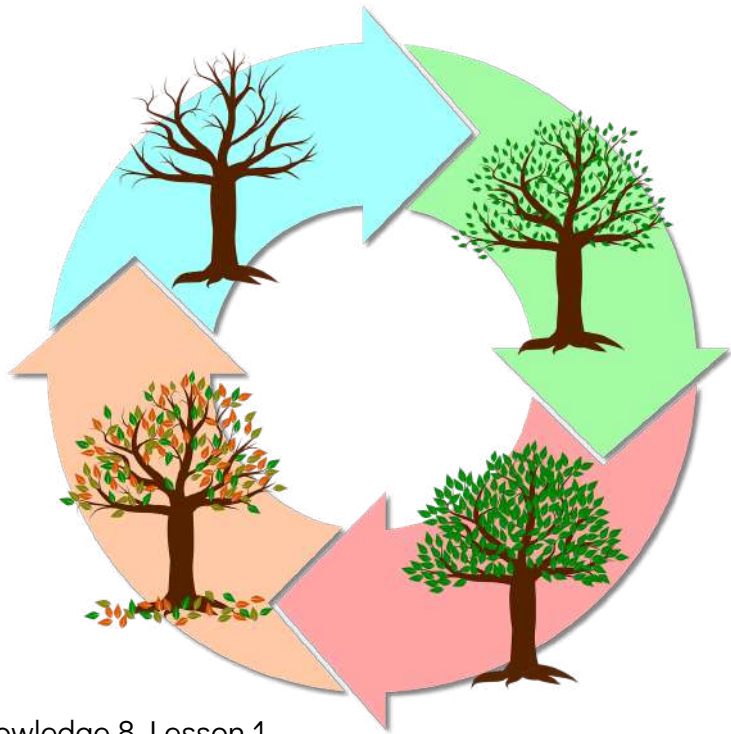

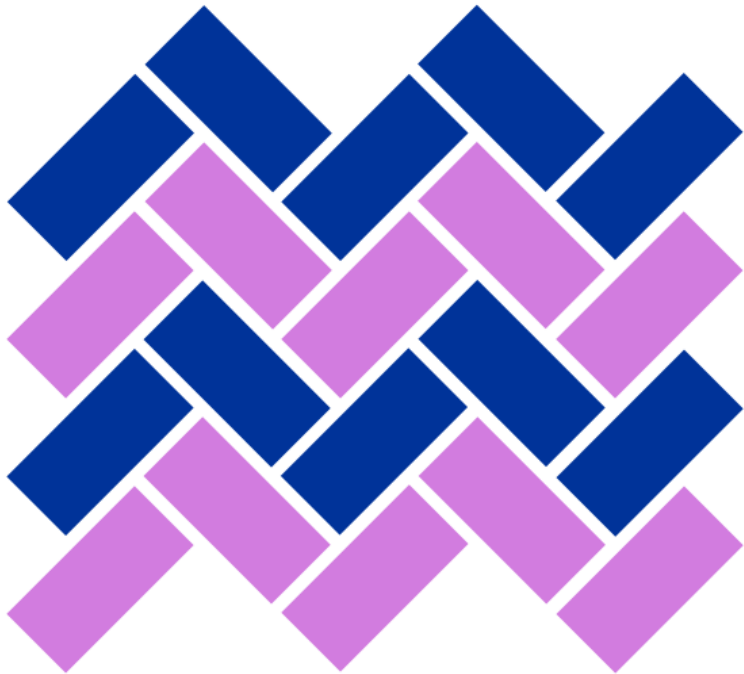

patterns

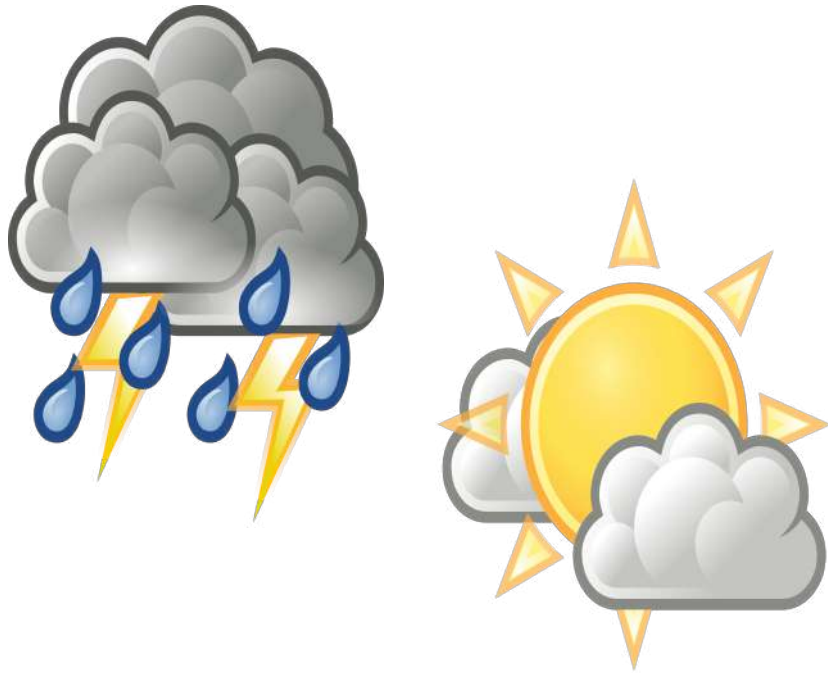
(n.) things that repeat themselves over and over

weather

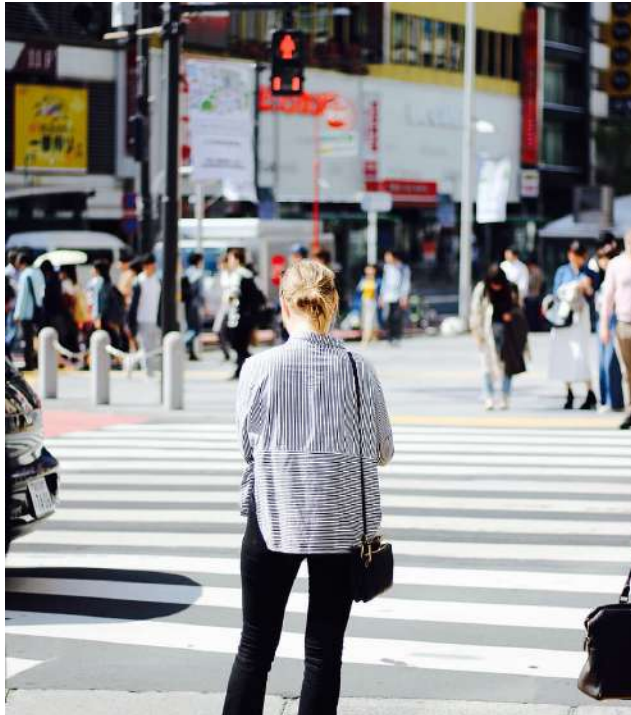
(n.) the temperature and other outside conditions at a particular time and place

snow

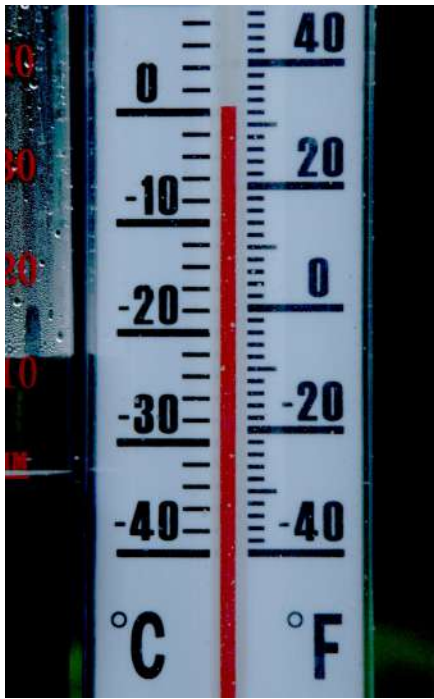

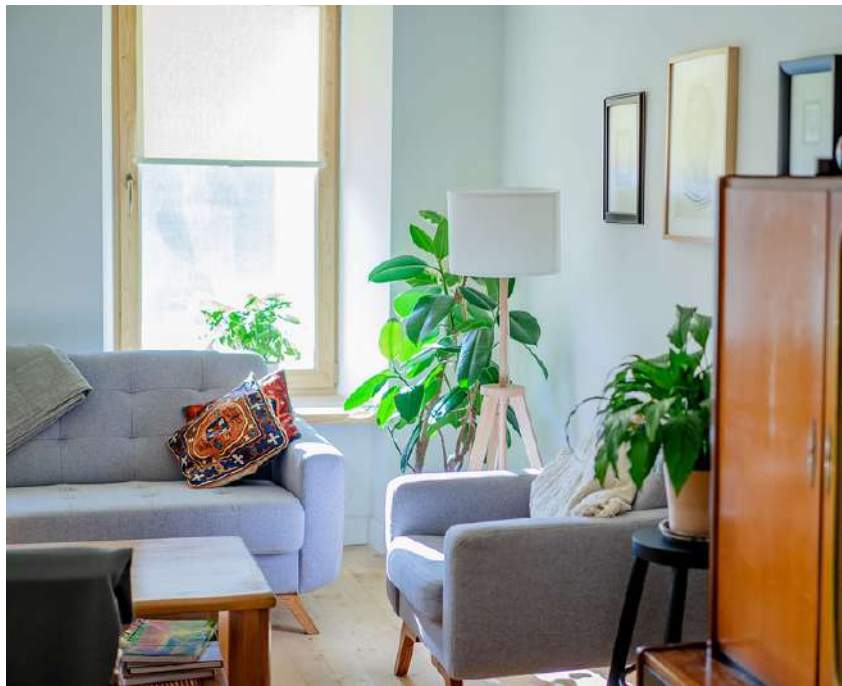

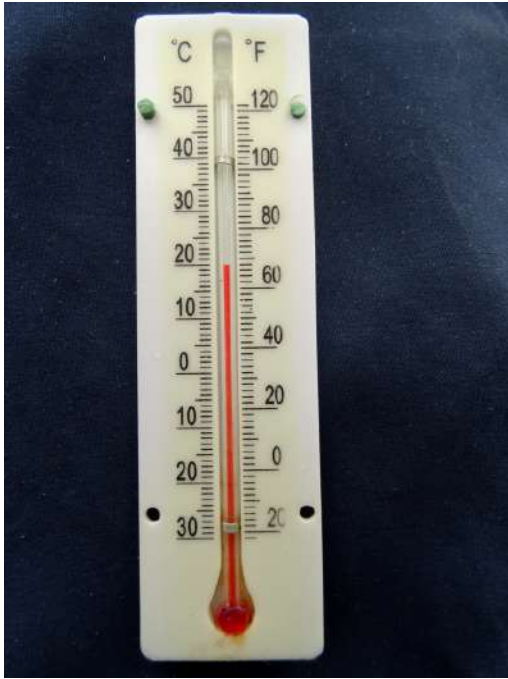
