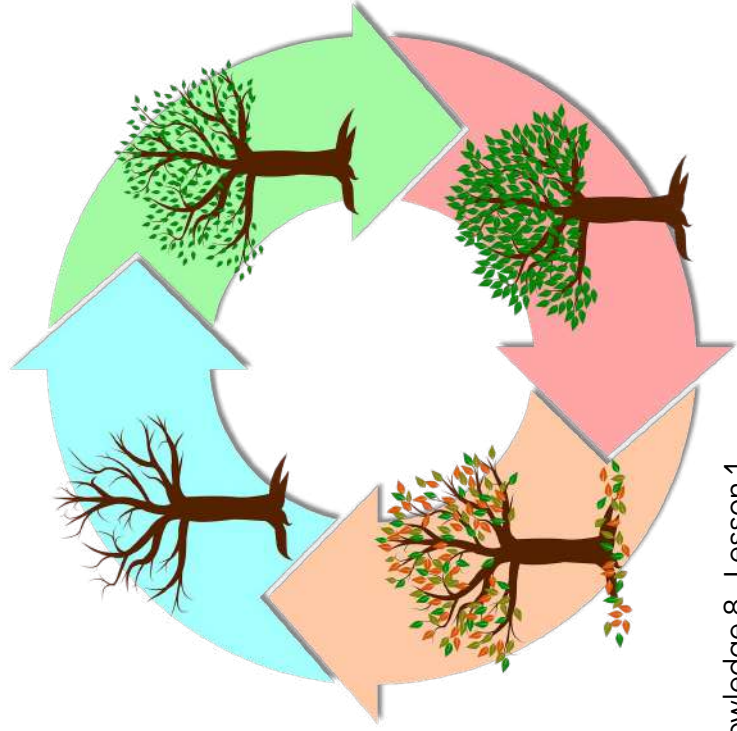

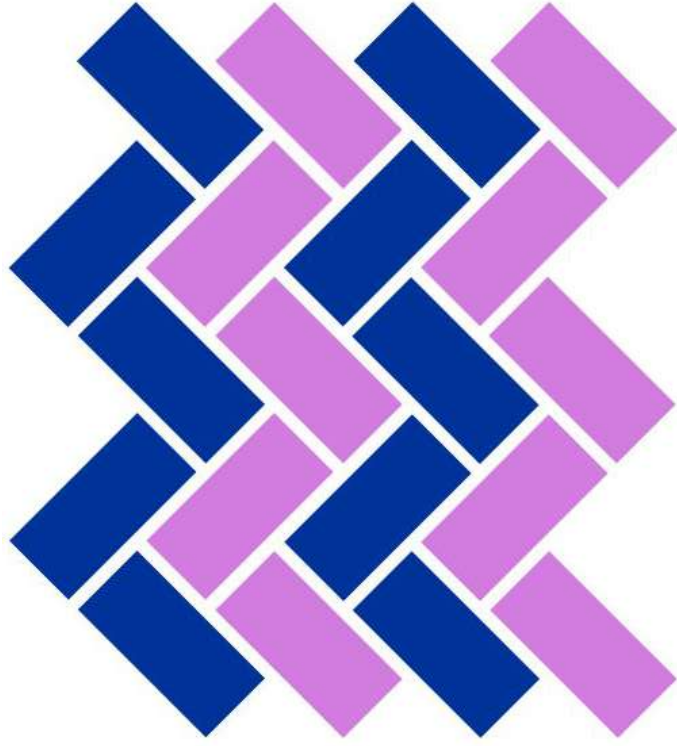

cycle

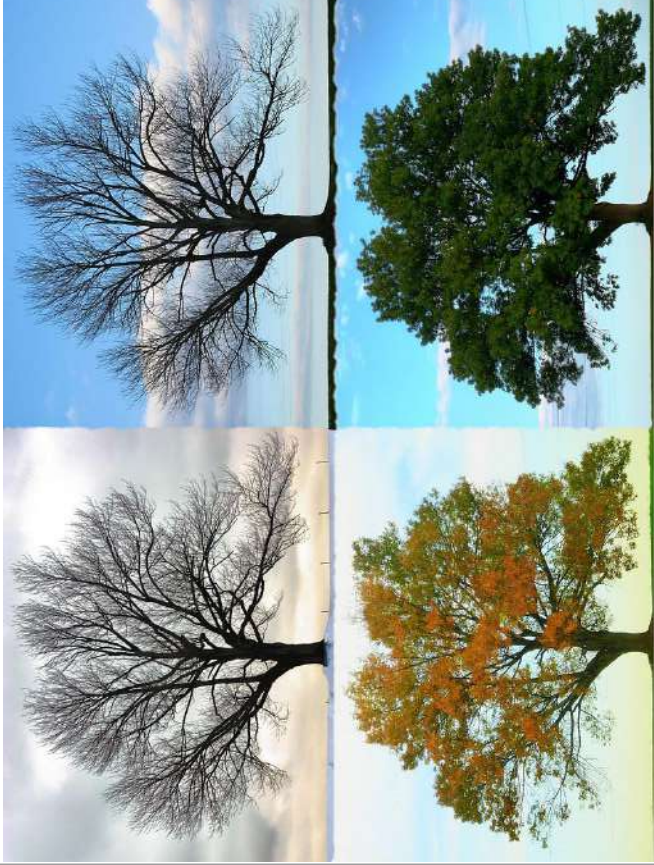
(n.) events that happen over and over in the same order

patterns

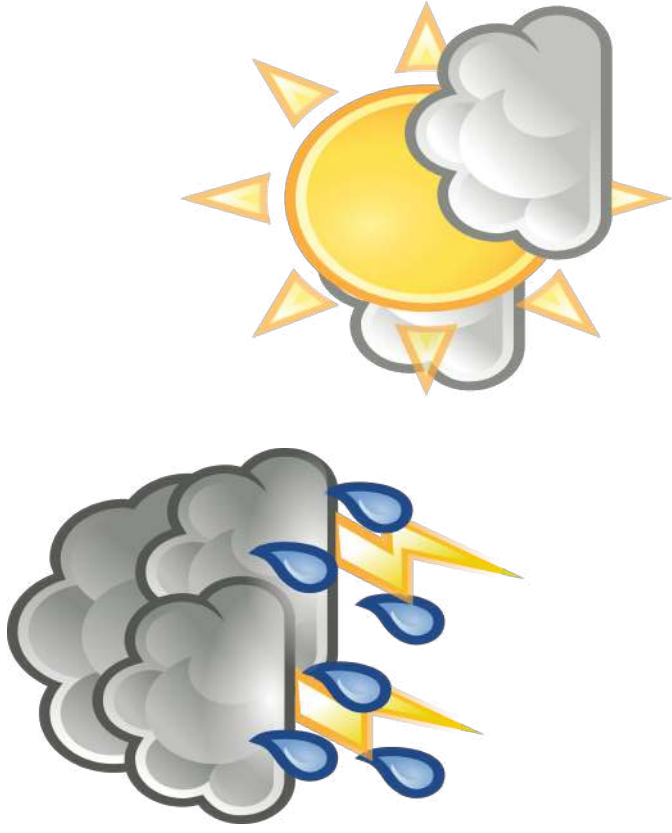
(n.) things that repeat themselves over and over

blizzards

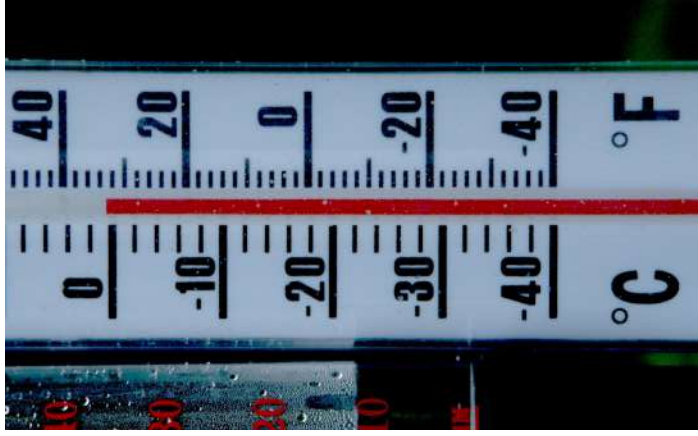
(n.) heavy snowstorms with a lot of wind and snow

(v.) to melt or soften after being frozen



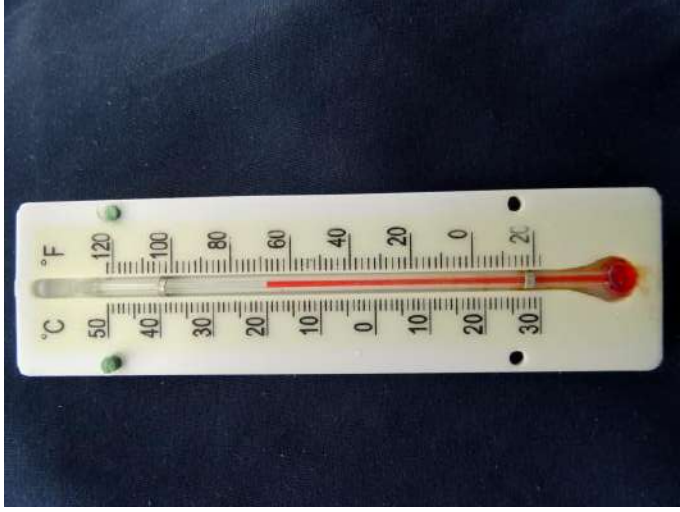

(n.) a sudden, sharp blow

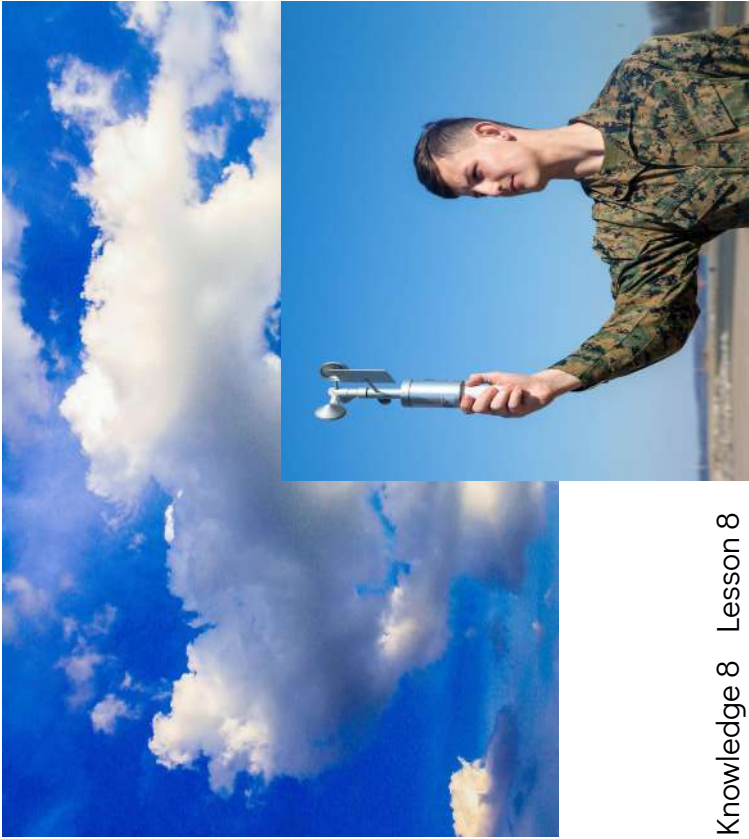
