Steven Michael Janeda was the youngest of 9 children of Joseph and Sarah Janeda. All 5 sons served in the U.S. Army. Steve became a member of St. Paul's Evangelical Church in 1963. He attended Brownsville Elementary and graduated from River High School in 1967. Steve joined the Army in 1969 and took basic training at Ft. Knox, Kentucky. After basic training, he went to Ft. Benning, Georgia for parachute training. Steve then volunteered to go to Vietnam. He left for Vietnam in March 1970. On May 26, 1970 he gave the ultimate sacrifice and was killed in action.

His brother James Janeda, who also served in Vietnam, a graduate of River High School has set aside funding for this scholarship as a memorial of his brother so that future generations can benefit from the sacrifices of those who have served our country.

The Steven Michael Janeda Memorial Scholarship will award \$1,500 Scholarship to a Student pursuing a post high school education. This includes 4 year Bachelor Degree, 2 year Associate degree or trade school at an accredited school or university. He/She must be a full time student taking a minimum of 12 semesters hours.
