Structure of a Small Group Strategy Lesson

Inform (1-2 min)	Quickly tell students why you've gathered them together
	Explicitly name a teaching point
Present (2-3 min)	 Quickly demonstrate by modeling using a read aloud text or shared reading text
	 Using think aloud to expose your strategy use
Engage (4-5 min)	 Have students try the strategy in their own reading book, a shared reading text or by reading a portion of a read aloud text
	 Coach and provide scaffolding and support
Reiterate (1 min)	Restate the teaching point
	 Remind students to use the strategy in their independent reading

	 Set a comprehension purpose for reading
Reading the Text	Listen to students read
