### **Senior Exam Notes:**

- Seniors are to attend all classes for which they are scheduled through Thursday, May 24. Students who have previously taken an AP or IB exam will have a graded culminating activity during their regularly scheduled exam period.
- No final exams should be administered early. No exceptions.
- Seniors who fail to take an exam as scheduled must have approval from the principal to make-up the exam on/by Friday, May 25.
- Senior exams are for seniors only. In classes where there is a mix of seniors and underclassmen, underclassmen must wait until their exams are administered the following week.
- Graduation Rehearsal will be held at the Bon Secours Wellness Arena on Thursday, May 31 at 12:00 p.m.
- Graduation will be held at the Bon Secours Wellness Arena on Monday, June 4 at 5:00 p.m.

### **Exam Notes:**

- Full Year English Classes will administer one exam that will be the grade of record for both classes.
- Full Year Algebra Classes will administer one exam that will be the grade of record for both classes.
- Students in second semester classes who take an End-of-Course Exam (US History, English 1, Algebra 1, and Biology) will have their end-of-course exams from May 25 June 5.
- Students in AP or IB classes **MUST** attend their regularly scheduled exam class period on June 1 and June 5. A final graded culminating activity in these classes that counts as a major test grade will be administered.

- We will not disrupt the order of school and those administering and taking exams for early dismissals. Under no circumstance is it acceptable for a teacher to inform students or parents that the class has ended and student attendance is not required.
- Exams must be comprehensive and challenging and should be sufficient in length to fully cover the 90 minutes allocated for the exam.

### **Exam Rules:**

- The exam schedule is to be followed to the letter. **Exams will not be administered early** and no exams are to be administered at any other time than their scheduled times.
- Every class at Greer High School will administer a 90 minute exam that covers the content of the curriculum taught and provides sufficient rigor and challenge. No class or student is exempt from exams.
- Students who fail to stand the examination at the appointed time are to receive a zero.
- The principal will review absences of students and determine their eligibility to makeup missed exams. DO NOT ADMINISTER ANY MAKE-UP EXAMINATIONS UNLESS APPROVED BY THE PRINCIPAL.
- Early dismissals for exams will be considered for medical, dental, funerals, and extreme emergency as excused by the principal.
