Student Assignment Review - Phase I

- Match enrollment to new capacities of Angier, Zervas and Cabot
 - School building projects currently in implementation phase
 - New buildings to be larger than their current assigned populations:
 - Angier additional capacity: 35 students (est.)
 - Zervas additional capacity: 150 students (est.)
 - ▶ Cabot additional capacity 80 students (est.)



Student Assignment Review – Future Phases

- Match student assignment plans in phases to parallel the Long-Range Facilities plan for Elementary Schools
 - Phase II: Mid-Range projects, Peirce, Williams
 - Phase III: Planned major projects, Lincoln-Eliot, Ward, plus mid-range projects
