- *AP Score of 3 or Higher
- *Pass 2 Dual Credit Classes (C or higher)
- *ACT (20+) or SAT (1020+) Scores
- *Work-Based Learning
- *CTE Completer w/Certification (Pathways on next page)
- *Silver or higher on WIN Test
- *ASVAB score of 31 or higher

- The number of electives you choose will depend on how many other courses you were recommended for by your teachers
- Most students will choose 4 electives and 3 alternate electives
- Your unit total when registering should equal 7!

Why Do I Have To Choose Alternates???

- Sometimes there are scheduling conflicts that do not allow you to receive all of the courses that are your first choice.
- If you do not select alternates, a counselor will have to choose a course for you if there is a conflict.
