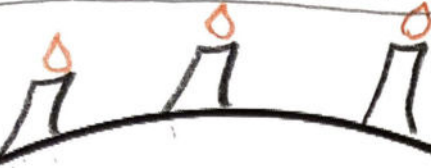
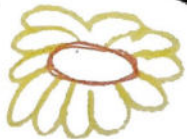


DAY OF THE DEAD



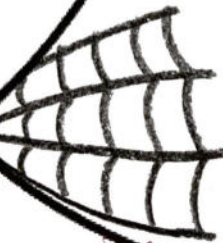
- Celebrated on November 1st - 2nd

- pan de muertos



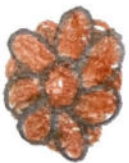
