

# STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

## Using Digital Devices in The Arts

Resources are often provided by the school for students to enhance and support learning. There is always additional time required in learning how to safely and effectively use resources. It is expected that all students will try their best to use school resources to improve their learning.

For all students, this means:

### All resources

- Follow all rules and instructions from school staff
- If you do not know the best way to use something, ASK the teacher
- If you see something uncomfortable or inappropriate, TELL the teacher
- Take accountability for what you do – be responsible
- Do not distract others in class
- Do not get distracted by what others are doing
- Do not interfere with another student's work
- Leave your workplace neat, tidy and organised

### Digital resources (computers, iPads, cameras, etc.)

- Use devices only as instructed
- Do not eat or drink near devices
- Save your documents regularly
- Avoid inappropriate stuff online – do not click on online ads
- Do not change settings without permission
- Print only if you have permission
- Get permission before you take a photo or video of someone, from the person and from a teacher
- Take regular breaks to change position – this will keep your brain active
- Maintain good posture when working – this will help prevent repetitive strain
