- ☐ 1 pk. multi-colored highlighters
- ☐ 1 pk. mixed colors ball-point pens
- ☐ 2 of each - Dark blue and black ink pens
- ☐ 1 roll “Scotch Tape”
- ☐ 2 pks. lined, punched notebook paper
- ☐ 1 pk. 3” x 5” lined index cards
