STUDENT ATHLETIC TRAINING Mrs. Ellen Troxell

Elective Course- 1 semester long

Definition of athletic training: The prevention, recognition, evaluation, treatment, and rehabilitation of athletic injuries.

<u>**Grading**</u>: All assignments are graded on a point basis, determined by the number of required answers. Example: 27 answers = 27 points.

- 1. <u>*Homework*</u>: One assignment per chapter, which must be turned in on time. If it is received late, the BEST grade possible is half the total value of the assignment. Example: of a possible 32 point assignment, the highest possible grade is 16 points. Then deductions are made for incorrect answers.
- 2. <u>*Tests:*</u> One test per chapter (usually). Review always precedes test day. Tests are usually announced 2 or 3 days in advance. If absent the day of the test, a make up test must be completed your first day back to school. If you arrive at school at a time after the test, you must see me that day before you go home to either take the test at the end of the day or to arrange a time in the future to take the test.
- 3. <u>Group Projects</u>: Students are put into small groups of 2 or 3 and are assigned a small section of the chapter to learn and present to the class by means of a verbal and visual presentation. Each group project is worth 25 points.
- 4. <u>*Taping Skill Tests:*</u> Taping skills are taught in class, and practiced on fellow students. Review at home is encouraged, and tape is made available for students to practice at home. Taping skills are tested in class, and must be demonstrated from memory. Students are graded on neatness and accuracy. If absent the day of a taping test, testing must be made up your first day back to school or as soon as possible by appointment with the teacher.
- 5. <u>*Final Exam*</u>: A 100 question multiple choice and true/false test is given. It is an overview of all material taught during the course. It is worth 10% of the final grade. I am required to give a final exam or assign a final project.
