Zoom Etiquette and Ground Rules

We are entering into a new world of Video Conferencing and we need to understand the ground rules for how to be great team mates in these moments

Camera and Lighting

- Have the camera at eye level
- Make sure you are front-lit (light coming from front or side, not behind)
- Look at the camera when talking, instead of at the screen
- Have video on during meetings, it helps connect to the rest of the team and ensures trust

Sound

- When you're not talking, make sure you mute your mic
- Raise your hand if you want to add to the conversation

Distractions

- Pay attention to your background, make sure it's appropriate
- Try not to eat during meetings if possible
- Be attentive, avoid multitasking
- Avoid private behavior, remember that people can see you at all times
- Be professional, don't distract your team
- If you can be in a room with a closed door it helps to prevent distractions
