



	*Truman has announced a set of reforms called the "Baindeal", including call to raise the minimum wage and enact national health insurance. *With rising prices and growing unemployment, workers in major industries are calling for wage increases and are striking if their demands are not met. *In response to the strikes, Congress has passed the Tait-Hartley Act, limiting the power of labor unions. *The Taft-Hartley Act outlaws the Closed Shop or a workplace in which the employer agrees to hire only members of a certain union. It also bans sympathy strikes by other unions.








