The Menifee County School District will begin the Summer Feeding Program on Monday, June 3, 2019, and complete service on Wednesday, July 31, 2019. One holiday will be observed during this period of: Thursday, July 4, 2019, meals will not be provided on that date. The Central kitchen will be located at the Menifee High School.
