#### **Program Description:**

- Grades 3-7 Visual and Performing Arts Electives: Back by popular demand, students currently enrolled in Paramus Schools grades 3-7 may participate in visual and/or performing arts electives. Students do not need to attend the morning academic program to participate in the arts electives. Students will select TWO arts electives that will run for four weeks with a culminating performance and/showcase on the last day of camp. Elective choices will include dance, art, group music lessons (band/orchestra) and musical theater. (Champions students may be transported to and from the program by bus.)
- Grades K-7: Full Day Option: A full day option consisting of academic support in the morning and fun, personal enrichment electives in the afternoon. Academics will include a review of key grade level concepts and skills in language arts and mathematics. ESL in-class or pull-out support will be available. (Champions students may be transported to and from the program by bus. No additional busing is provided.)

Students will sign up for 2 daily electives that will take place each day for two week cycles. Here is an example of an elective schedule: Weeks 1 and 2: a) Kids, Clay and Artistic Play b) Kitchen Science; Weeks 3 and 4: a) Just Dance b) Lego Mania. You may view elective course offerings and sign up for electives through CommunityPass on March 1st.

- Grades K-7: Half Day Option: A half day option for academics only during the morning. Academics will include a review of key grade level concepts and skills in language arts and mathematics. ESL in-class or pull-out support available. (Champions students may be transported to and from the program by bus. No additional busing is provided.)
- Grades 8-11 Half Day Option Only: A half day program of academics in the morning is available for students in grades 8-11 with the choice of language arts, mathematics, or both. ESL in-class or pull-out support available. There is no full day option for students in grades 8-11.
