 - Was there a problem and how was it solved?

 - What new thing did you learn in this book?
 - Does the story remind you of something that happened to you? If so, how is your experience like the book?
3. **Complete a Log Entry.**
 - Write the title and author of your book.
 - Use the questions above to draw and/or write about your book.

- * Required titles should be read by scholar rising from the previous grade to next grade level. Scholars in Grades PreK-1 are required to read the required title and select two titles of choice. Students may choose from a list of ten titles (see Summer Reading page) , from the public library's list, or other sources.

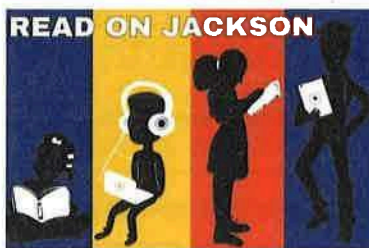

Directions for Summer Reading Log
