### How will students know about the required summer reading?

1. Teachers will meet with incoming students before summer break to introduce the assigned book, explain the requirements and read an excerpt of the book aloud. This will occur as follows:

4<sup>th</sup> grade teachers meet with 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students - during 3<sup>rd</sup> grade visit to Greenview

5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers meet with 4<sup>th</sup> grade students - TBD by Greenview teachers

6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers meet with 5<sup>th</sup> grade students - TBD by Greenview teachers

 $7^{th}\,grade$  teachers meet with  $6^{th}\,grade$  students - during  $6^{th}\,grade$  visit to Memorial

8<sup>th</sup> grade teachers meet with 7<sup>th</sup> grade students - TBD by Memorial teachers

9<sup>th</sup> grade teachers meet with 8<sup>th</sup> grade students - TBD by Brush teachers

- 2. Students will receive a hard copy of the summer reading requirement (TBD by each school. E.g. In weekly take-home communication folder, distributed during summer reading presentation, etc).
- 3. Summer reading requirements will be posted on the district website.

# What will it be worth towards my 1st quarter grade?

Summer reading will be worth 5% (per book if required to read 2) of the overall 1<sup>st</sup> quarter grade.

### What are the due dates?

The book must be completely read by August 17<sup>TH</sup>. Project and written responses are due by August 25<sup>TH</sup> (7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>: An in-class assessment will be given on September 2<sup>nd</sup>).

# What happens if it's not turned in on time?

No late work will be accepted.

# What about new enrollees?

During registration (until July 31<sup>st</sup>), they will be given a copy of the guidelines for required summer reading. New enrollees after August 1<sup>st</sup> will be exempt from required summer reading.

# How will students get copies of the books?

Students are required to independently obtain a copy of the required reading (E.g. local library, book store, digital download, pre-sale in school before school year ends, etc.).
