The Virginia State Department of the Gifted has again funded the summer enrichment program for gifted students who are in 5th through 7th grades for the 2022-2023 school year. The following information is provided so that students interested in participating may complete and return the attached application to the listed address no later than **Friday, May 12, 2023.** Participation in previous summer programs will not exclude students during the selection process.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Eastern Shore Regional Governor's School is a two-week summer program for gifted students currently in grades five (5) through seven (7). The program is offered at no cost to the participants.

The science topic will change each year, allowing interested students to continue to participate for several consecutive summers. Enrollment in this program is limited to twenty-four (24) students. This year the topic will be Forensics.

This enrichment experience offers students an opportunity to explore a science topic in depth by conducting active investigations, participating in field experiences, research, using related technology, and by producing an individual project. Students will also explore various careers in Forensics.

LOCATION

The program is based at Nandua Middle School, 20330 Warrior Drive, Onley, VA 23418.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from Nandua Middle School will be provided by school buses the participating school divisions. Individual bus routes and designated pick up points and times will be arranged after notification of student selection for the program. Daytime field trip transportation will be provided by an ACPS school bus.

MEALS

Parents are responsible for providing their children with a practical lunch each day. Accomack County School will provide breakfast and lunch options to students. Parents are welcomed to provide their children with a lunch each day.

COST

There will be no program costs to students, although students will be expected to bring a packed lunch every day or sign up for the Accomack County Food Service offerings. It is also recommended that students bring water or other drinks due to the summer heat.
