The Jackson Public School District will offer a tuition summer school for JPSD students and non-JPSD students.

# **₩ WHERE WILL SUMMER SCHOOL BE HELD?**

Middle school site is Hardy Middle School (545 Ellis Avenue, Jackson, MS 39209).

#### **►** WHO MAY REGISTER FOR SUMMER SCHOOL?

Students who have failed a subject. Student's grades may not be below a 50 and they could not have failed more than 2 core courses. If a student has failed either Algebra I or 8<sup>th</sup> grade Math, those students will only be allowed to take that 1 class the entire duration of summer school due to Carnegie unit requirements.

# **► WHEN AND WHERE SHOULD MY CHILD REGISTER?**

To register for summer school, each student/parent should contact officials at his/her home school. Registration will begin May 9, 2017 – June 2, 2017 at the home school for JPSD students. However, students not attending a JPSD school should apply and pay at the summer school site. A letter from the principal of the school attended in 2016-2017 must be presented to the summer school principal indicating permission to attend the JPSD summer program and a current report card before enrolling. Priority of assignment to classes will be based upon the date of registration. Registration forms should be completely filled out and the Receipt Number (proof of payment) must be recorded on the Registration Form.

# ► WHAT COURSES WILL BE OFFERED?

Student requests will determine subjects taught in summer school. No subject area tested courses will be offered in Summer School for advancement (Algebra I, U.S. History, Biology, and English 10). Students who were enrolled in these courses and failed the course may enroll in the subject area tested courses.

#### → HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

A tuition of \$250.00 for one full unit (CASH ONLY - NO CHECKS - NO CREDIT). All fees are payable at the time of registration. Applications will be accepted only on June 5th at the summer school site.

# ► HOW LONG WILL SUMMER SCHOOL LAST?

Classes are scheduled from June 5, 2017 - July 21, 2017, from 7:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. for regular classes and 7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. for Algebra I and 8<sup>Th</sup> Grade Math classes, 5 days per week. **There will be no classes July 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Classes resume July 5<sup>th</sup>**

A make-up session will be held each term.
