Summer School Policies

- All students must attend in person until the course is completed. On the first day of summer school, all students must be present at 8:30 AM to receive their username and password for Plato, as well as other important information.
- Exceptions to first day attendance may be made due to another obligation only if it is communicated to an administrator at the high school prior to summer school beginning.
- Attendance is Mandatory; 3 sessions per week until the course is completed. All pre-tests, post-tests, and final exams must be taken at the high school during Summer School hours.
- Students must complete all coursework with a passing grade by the end of the Summer School term (July 27th). Extensions will not be granted.

Supervised Agriculture Experience (SAE) -

Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) provides students with opportunities to gain work experience in the agriculture field(s) in which they are interested. Students work with their Ag teacher, parents, and/or employers to get the most out of their SAE program. Your work experience areas could include placement, entrepreneurship, or research in 42 different fields. It is worth one credit.

Requirements: Student must work 15 hours each week of summer and meet with Ms. Stoten four times over the summer. This course can be used as the required Ag course to be involved with FFA during the 2023-2024 school year.
