S.T.R.E.A.M. themed camps will be offered weekly. All courses/lessons taught within the week will focus on one specific area of S.T.R.E.A.M. Students will be instructed by teachers in smaller groups based on appropriate classroom groupings. These courses are sure to be engaging, interactive and hands-on.

Summit Schools has operated in-person during the 2021-22 school year while following the health and safety guidelines as determined by the CDC and Linn County Public Health.
