Background

The English Language Arts (ELA) program at the elementary school level includes the *Journeys* program, published by Houghton Mifflin, copyright 2017, and adopted by Abington School District in 2017 for use in grades K-5. There is a need to update the instructional materials as the program is being discontinued. Further, there is a continued need for a comprehensive program that addresses the disciplines delineated in the Pennsylvania's Core Standards for English Language Arts while also addressing the need for knowledge-building and foundational skills referenced in the science of reading research.

An Elementary English Language Arts (ELA) committee is recommended to be established to review our pedagogical approach to teaching ELA, the content addressed, and the methodology utilized in the teaching and learning of ELA for students in grades K-5, to recommend appropriate instructional materials, to identify needs for professional learning, and to propose an implementation plan for the new materials.

Committee Charge

The Elementary ELA Committee will undertake a comprehensive review of the content addressed by state standards and make specific recommendations with regard to instructional materials for ELA. In the formulation of its recommendations, the committee is directed to consider:

- Chapter 4 mandates, PA Academic and Core Standards for English Language Arts, and the PDE Curriculum Framework for ELA
- Research related to evidence-based instructional practices and the essential components of ELA instruction, including methodology of content delivery
- Equitable practices and the diverse needs of our student population
- Professional development and parent/guardian resources
- Print and digital materials that integrate with existing systems

Committee Tasks and Responsibilities

- 1. Review Chapter 4 mandates, PA Academic and Core Standards for English Language Arts, and the PDE Curriculum Framework for ELA including reading, writing, speaking and listening.
- 2. Review educational research and literature to determine evidence-based instructional practices and the essential components of ELA instruction.
- 3. Develop an understanding of the pedagogical approach best suited to meet the learning needs of Abington students; establish priorities and review evaluation criteria.
- 4. Evaluate selected programs with respect to the criteria and guidelines established for the committee, with attention to comprehensiveness of program, methodology of content delivery, instructional framework designed to diverse learning needs, and technology integration.
- 5. Develop an implementation plan that addresses curriculum, instruction, and assessment as well as professional development for effective integration of the new ELA program and a long-range plan for continued support and monitoring.
- 6. Prepare a report that reflects the recommendations of the committee with respect to instructional materials, program implementation, and professional development.
