



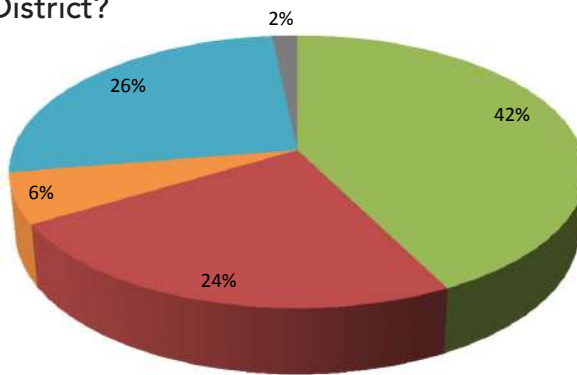
DISTRICT-WIDE SURVEY

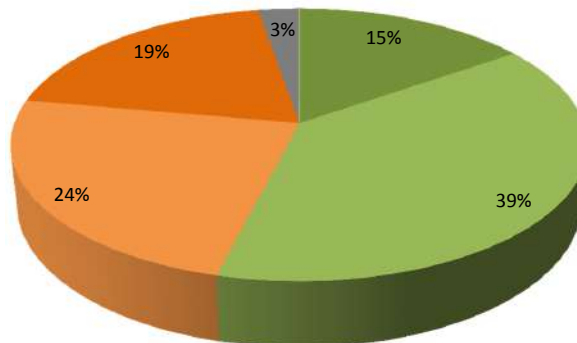

1. Given the long-term costs of each design option presented and the resulting tax implications, which of the following would you consider most beneficial for the Greenbush Middle River School District?



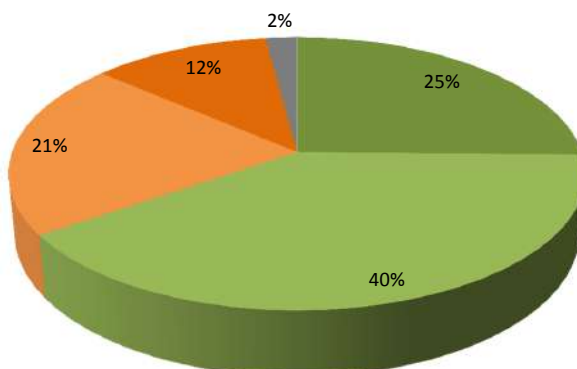

2. Do you believe the district has the capacity to invest in its facilities?



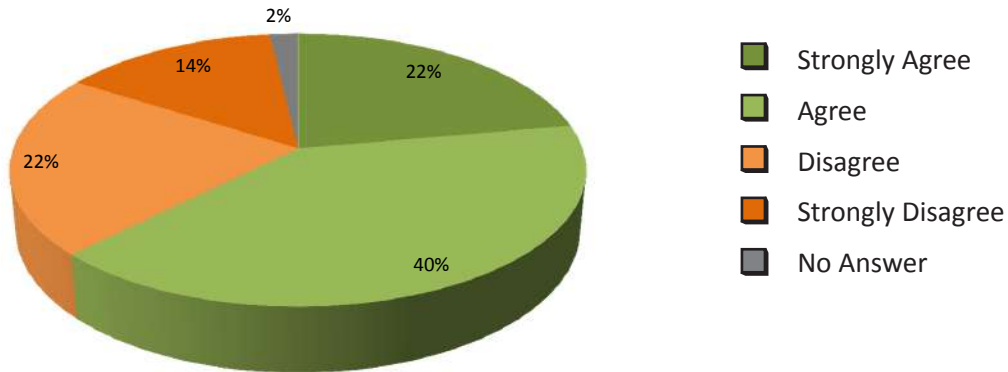

3. In your opinion, are the current buildings and grounds inviting and adequate for our students?

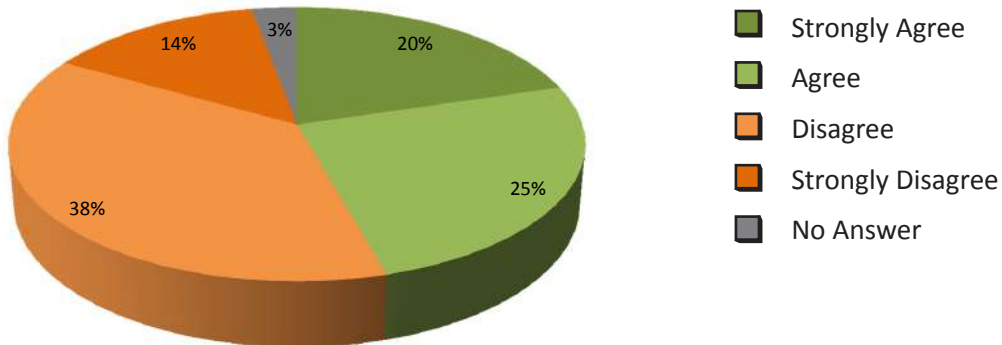

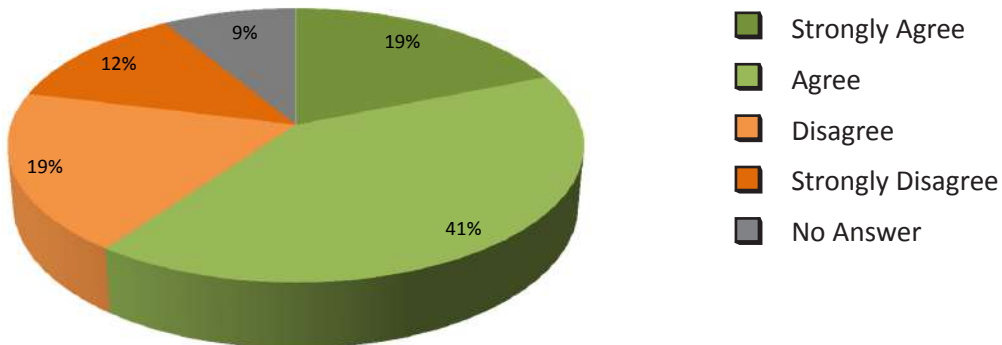
4. Based on current spaces available, do you feel extracurricular activities such as music, theater and sports have what is needed?



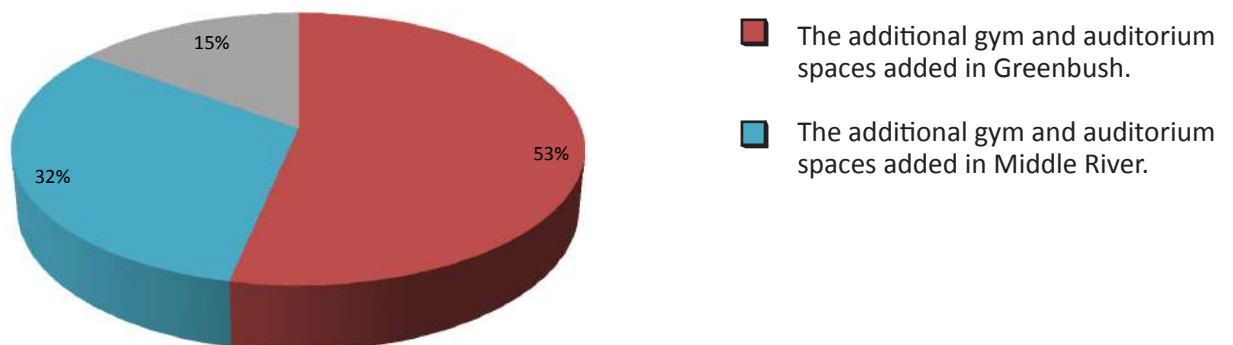
5. Do you feel it is important for all extracurricular activity spaces to be on the same site as academic spaces?



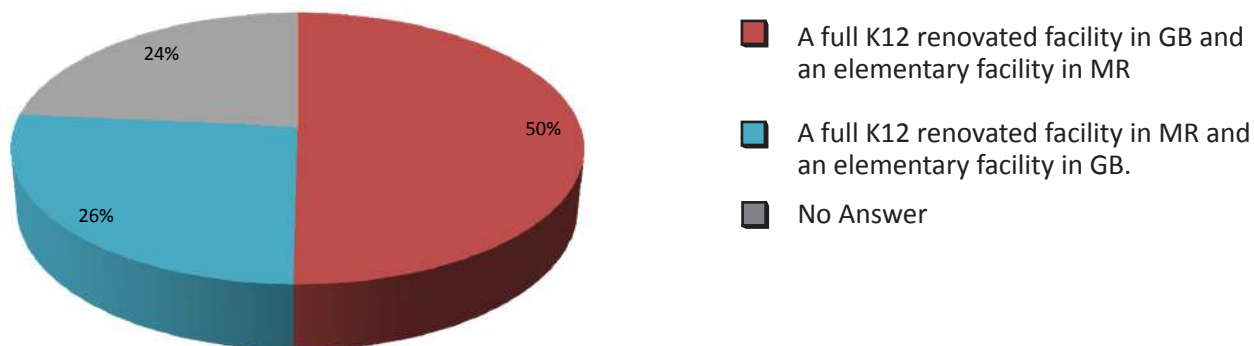
6. Is it desirable to have spaces that the community can easily use? If so, what would they be?



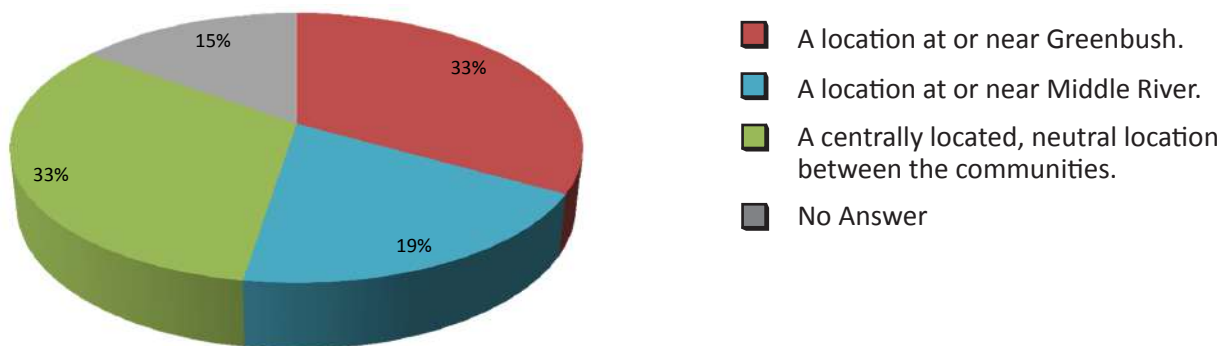
