Applying for a Scholarship through the Shenango Valley Community Foundation:

Step 1: SVCF scholarships are set up by STATE, COUNTY, HIGH SCHOOL or EXISTING COLLEGE STUDENTS/NON TRAD STUDENTS or CORPORATE. To see the scholarships available under that category you would click on the category listed and continue to scroll through this list.

Step 2: Make sure you review all of the scholarship requirements – there is a PDF link associated with each scholarship that will provide specific instructions on the scholarship requirements and deadline date. An application is attached to the instructions page that can be downloaded if you prefer not to submit the application on-line. There are some scholarships that do not have a specific application – in those cases a notation is made to contact your high school counselor

Step 3: Complete the application, online or a paper application. Make sure you provide all of the required documentation; transcripts, letters of reference and essay.

Step 4: Inform Mrs. Kellar, in the Guidance office, of which scholarships you applied for and ask for a copy of your official transcript to be sent.

YOUR APPLICATION IS NOT CONSIDERED COMPLETED UNTIL ALL OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE PROVIDED.
