

## STUDENT/PARENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2021-22 REGISTRATION

Dear Parents and Students,

February 2021

We are excited to begin the registration process for the 2021-22 school year. SVHS counselors will present Registration information to high school students via a Canvas module the week of February 8th. **Online course selections must be entered into both Powerschool and Canvas by Thursday, February 25th.** SVHS counselors will begin reviewing student course selections in Power School starting on March 1st and will email each student with confirmation of their selections. We hope to complete this process by Spring Break.

**IMPORTANT:** In addition to selecting courses in Powerschool, students need to complete the Registration Completion form in the Canvas module indicating what classes they have requested. This serves as a backup in case there are technical challenges with Powerschool- i.e., you can't get your selections to save and submit due to not having your selections in the correct categories.

### **STEP ONE: COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION MODULE IN CANVAS**

- ✓ You will work your way through the module to view the presentation/power point to get course sequence information
- ✓ Decide on 8 TOP choice courses (4 core classes and 4 electives) as well as 4 ALTERNATE elective choices

**If unsure of the level of class (College Prep or Honors) you should register for, please discuss this with your current teacher. Teachers will be submitting recommendations to counselors for core classes to ensure all students are scheduled appropriately:**

### **Remember Pre and Co- Requisites (This information is found in the Program of Studies):**

- ❓ Example 1: Math I before Drafting I; Public Safety before Firefighter 1
- ❓ Example 2: Visual Art I before Photography and Ceramics; Theatre Arts I before Theatre Arts II
- ❓ Band- Indicate both semesters on registration form/online since the course is yearlong

## STEP TWO: COMPLETE REGISTRATION IN POWER SCHOOL

### Instructions for Student Registration through PowerSchool

1. Student signs in PowerSchool.
2. Click “Class Registration” in the left-hand column.
3. Click the box with a pencil on the right-hand side of the page beside each Course Subject listed to see available courses to choose from.
4. Once you have selected your course(s), click “Okay” and continue down the page and hit submit.

\* Make sure you register for 8 courses and 4 alternate electives.

\*\* Please make sure you also make your selections in the REGISTRATION COMPLETION FORM found in the Canvas module as a backup.

Mathematics	4 credits	Math I, II, III, and a fourth math* Options include: *NC Math 4 * Pre-Calculus Honors * Discrete Math
Science	3 credits	Earth Science, Biology, and a Physical Science* (this can be: * Physical Science * Chemistry OR * Physics
Social Studies	4 credits	World History, American History, Civic Literacy & Economics & Personal Finance
World Language	2 credits	Not required for graduation, but required for 4 year college admissions
Health/PE	1 credits	Health & PE
Electives	6 credits	Any combination from either Career and Technical Education (CTE), Arts Education, World Languages, JROTC, or Other Academic Subject Area
