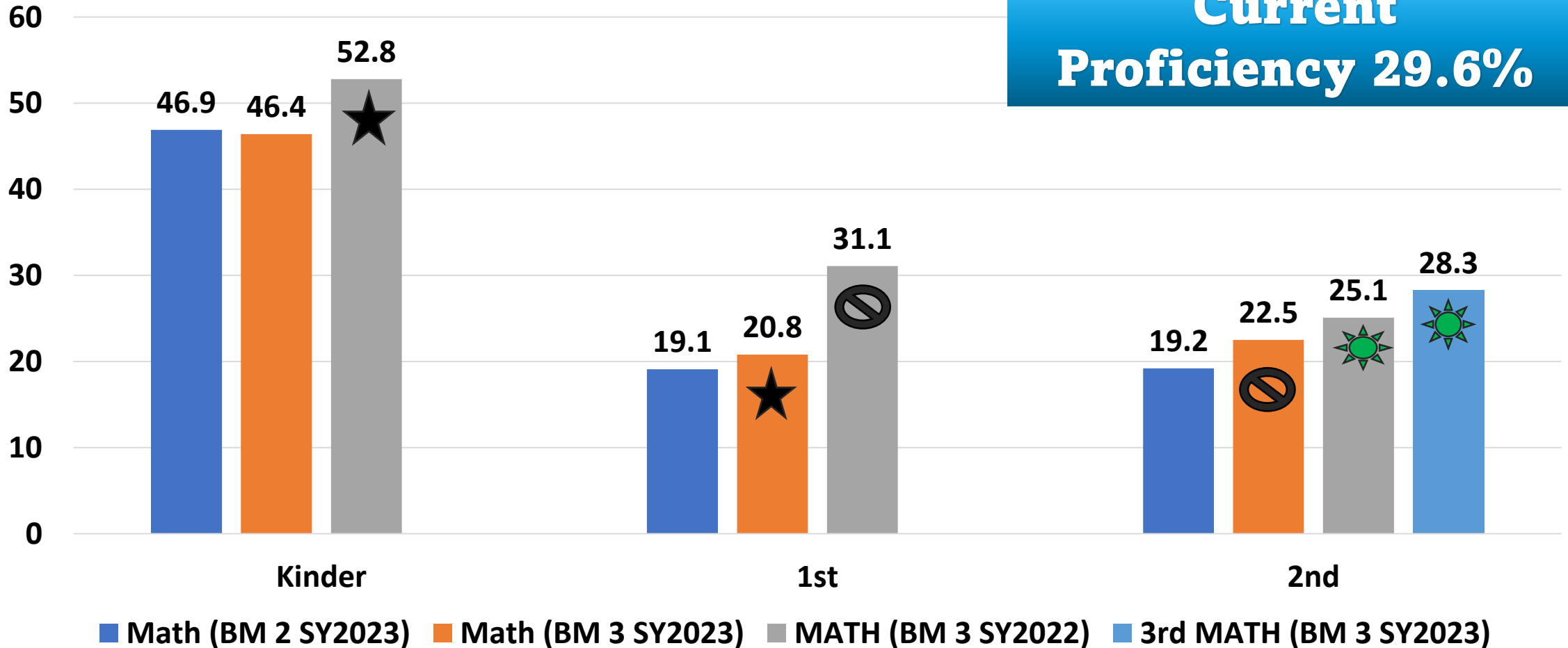

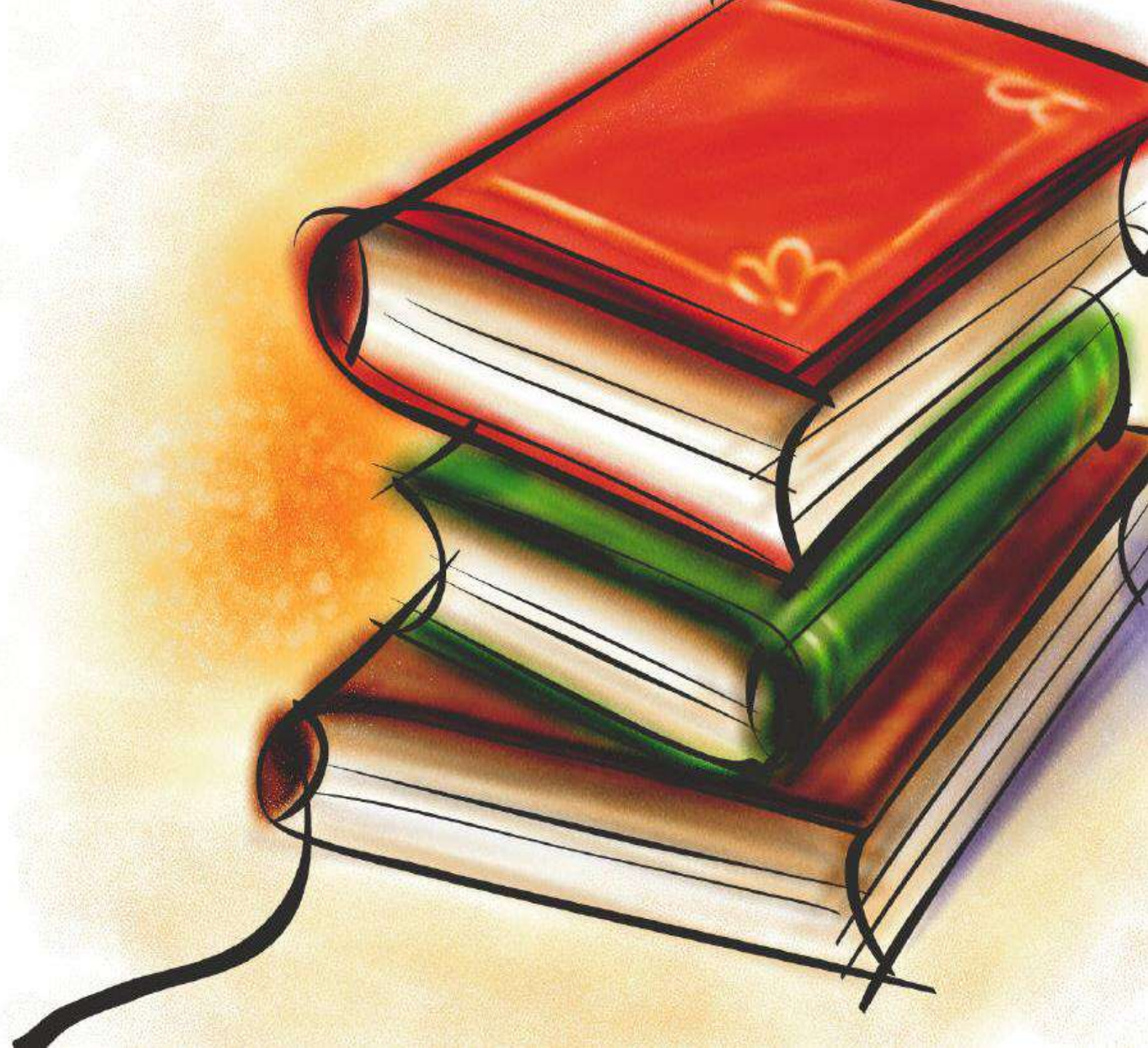

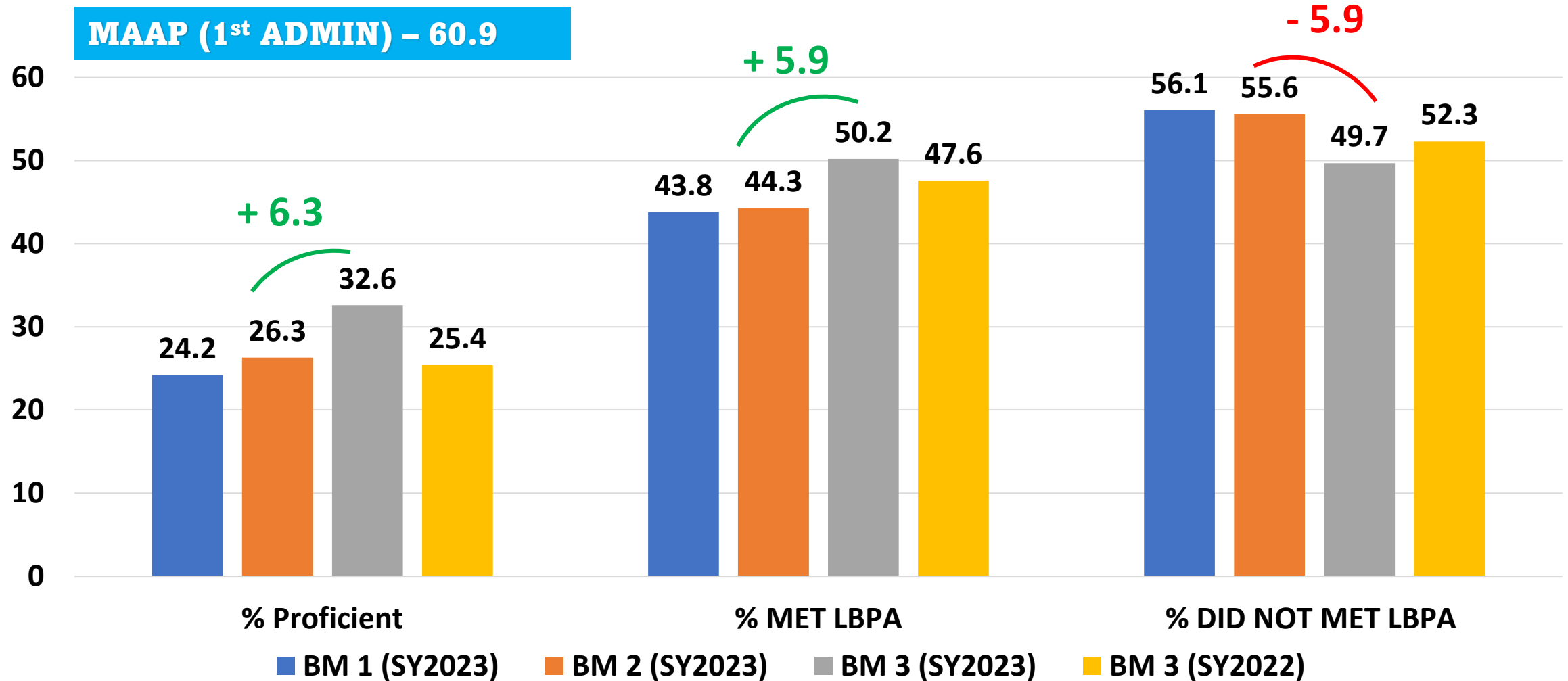
(Grades 3 – 12) Benchmark 1 - Benchmark 3 Overall Proficiency – Rate of Change



Benchmark 3 SY22 VS Benchmark 3 SY23 Overall Proficiency (Grades 3 – 12)



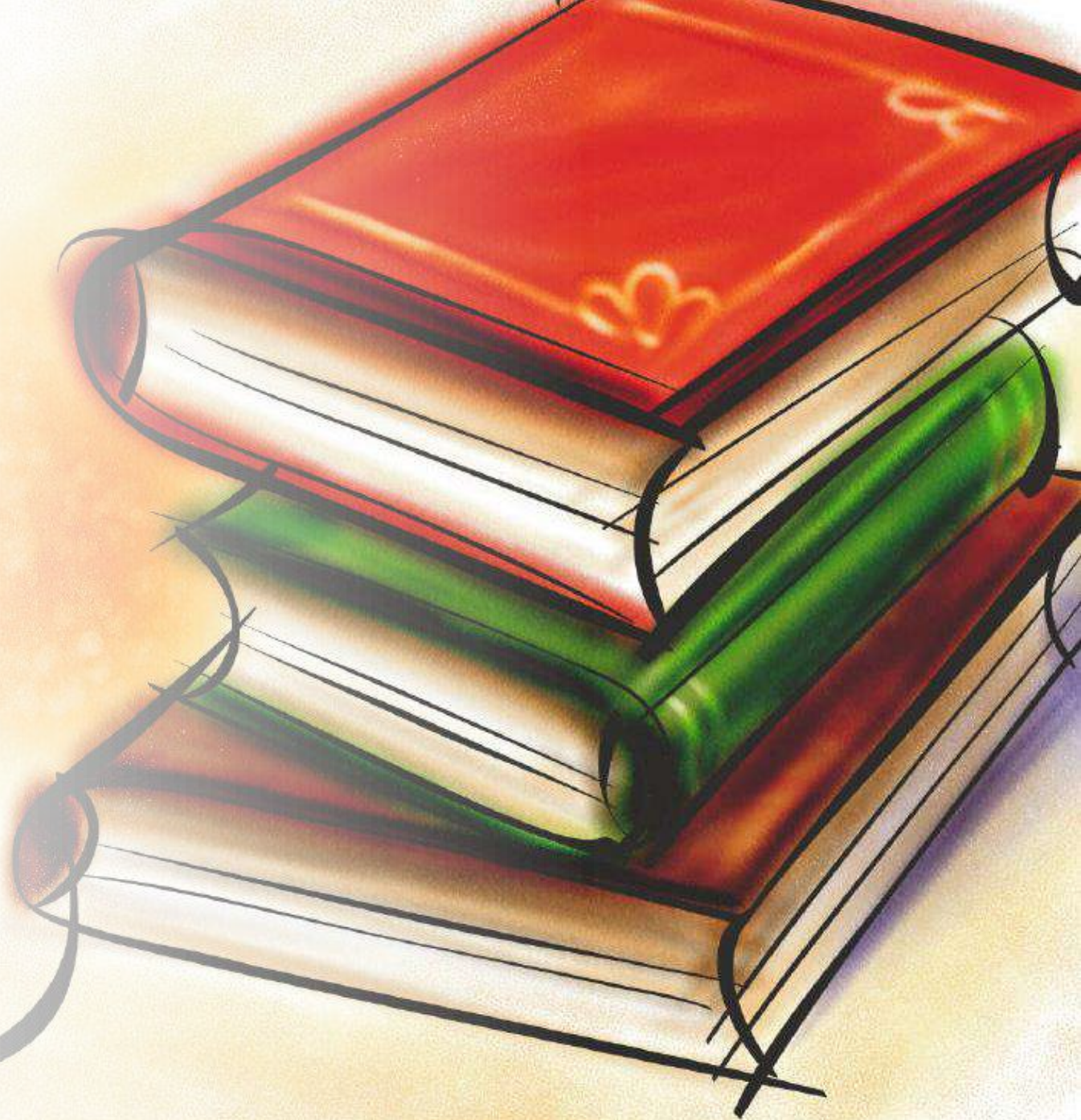

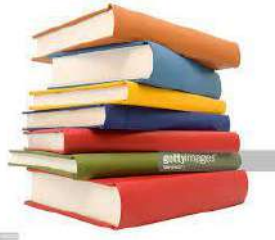




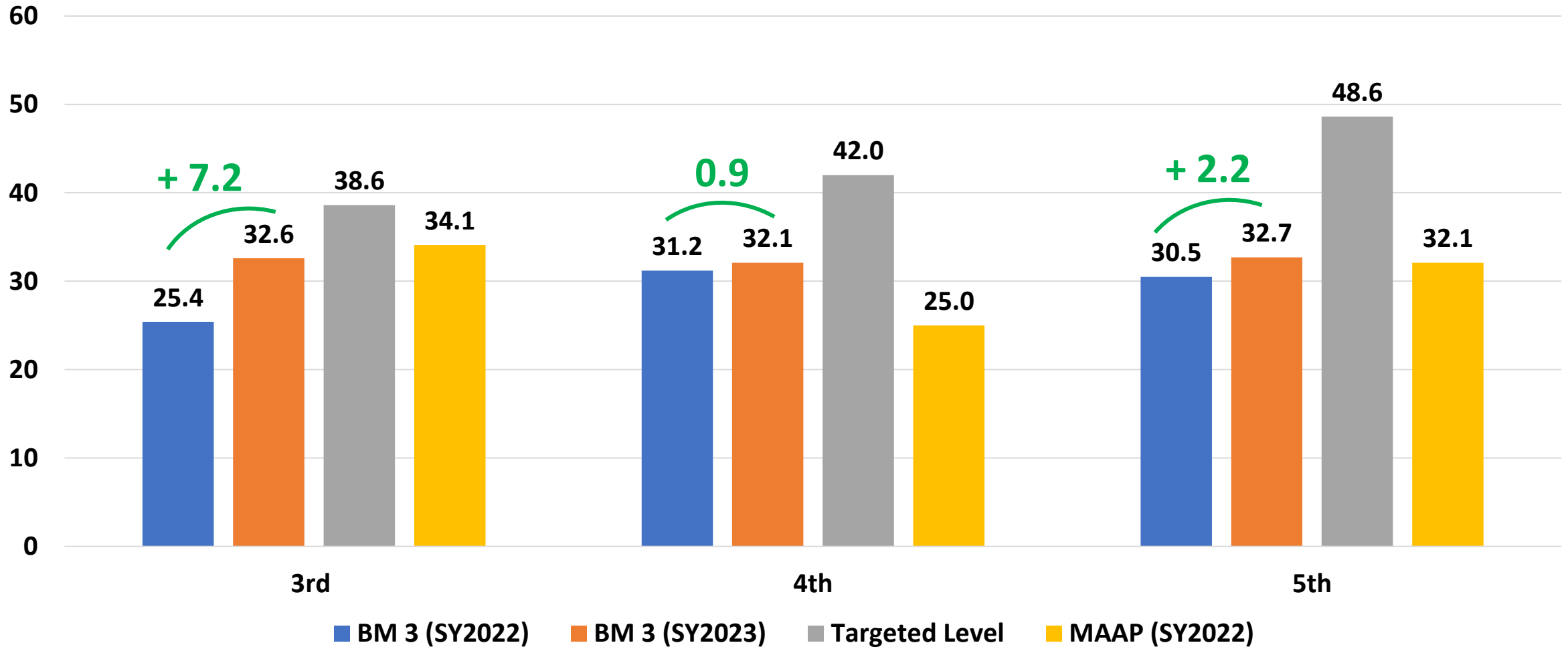
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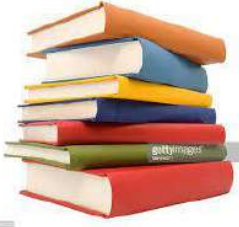
ELA Proficiency By Grade Level



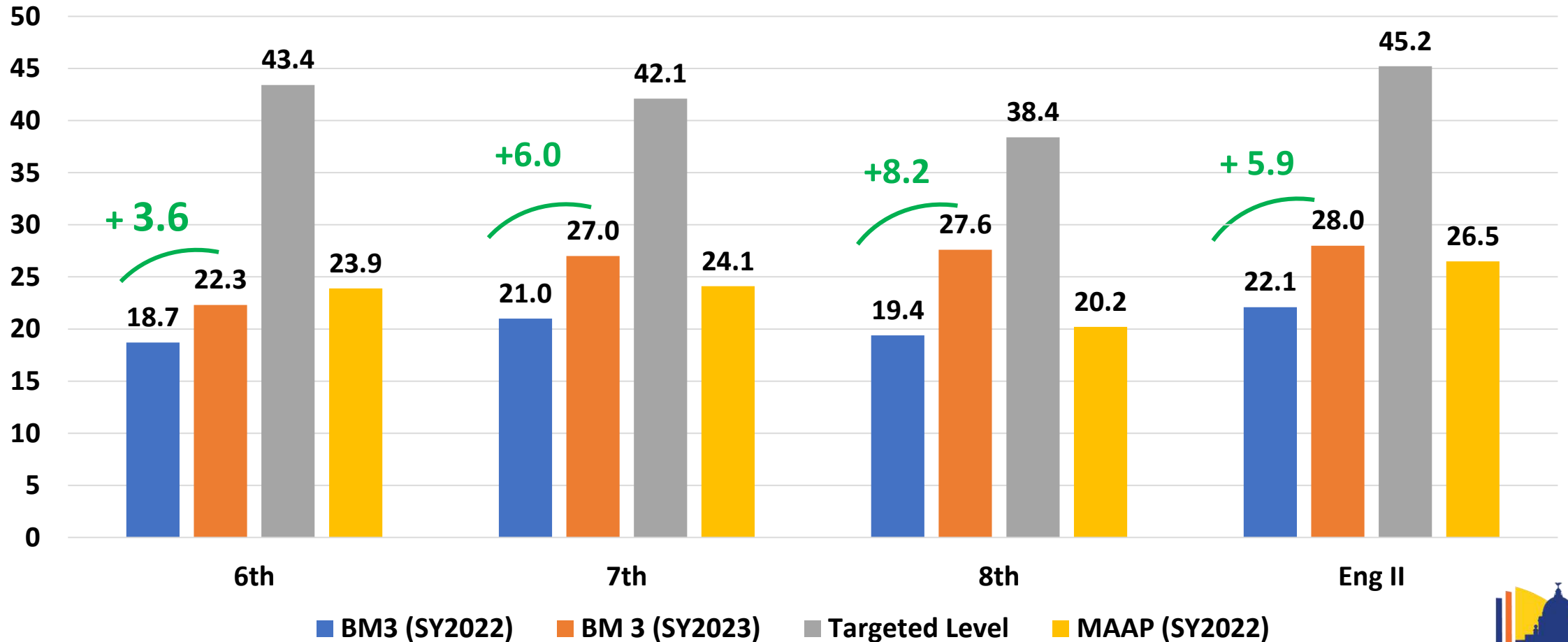


Elementary ELA Benchmark 3



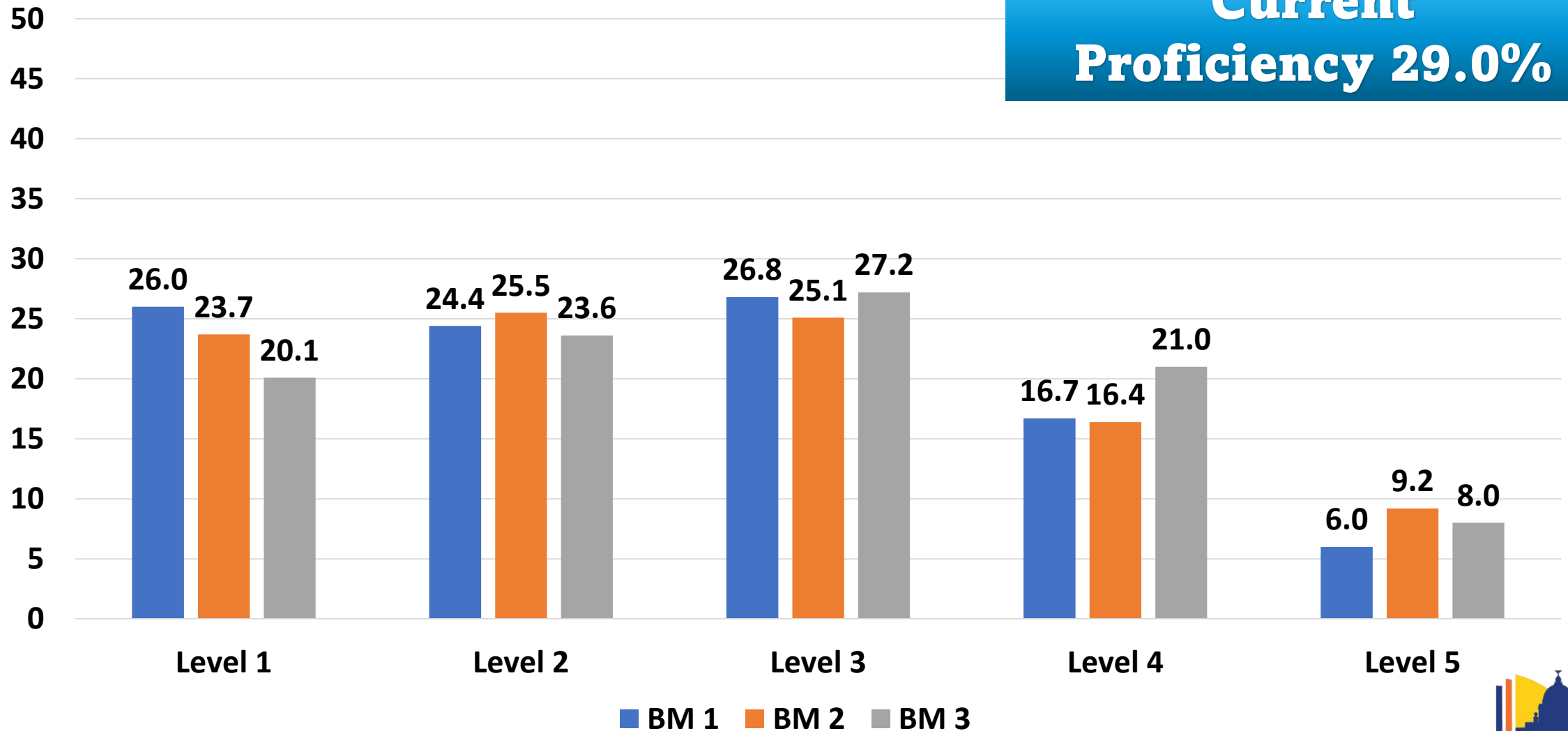


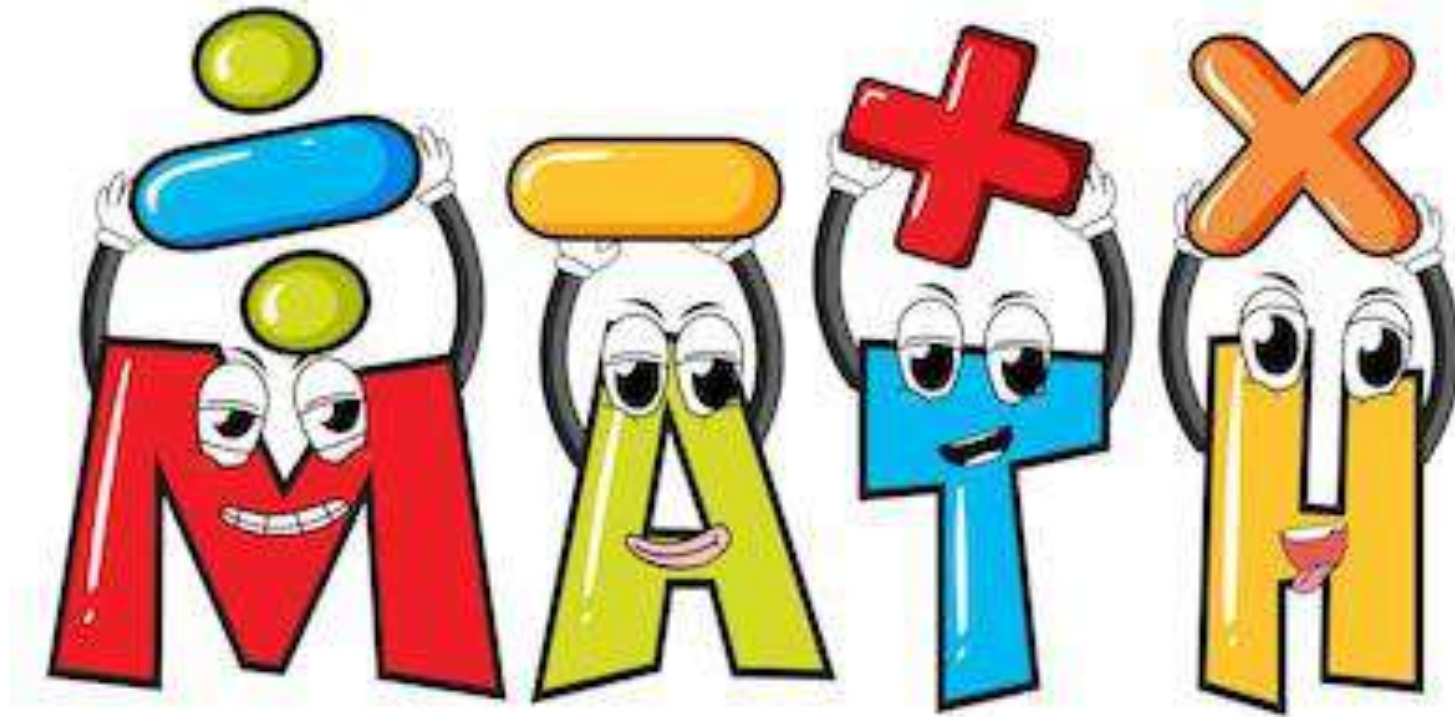
Secondary ELA Benchmark 3

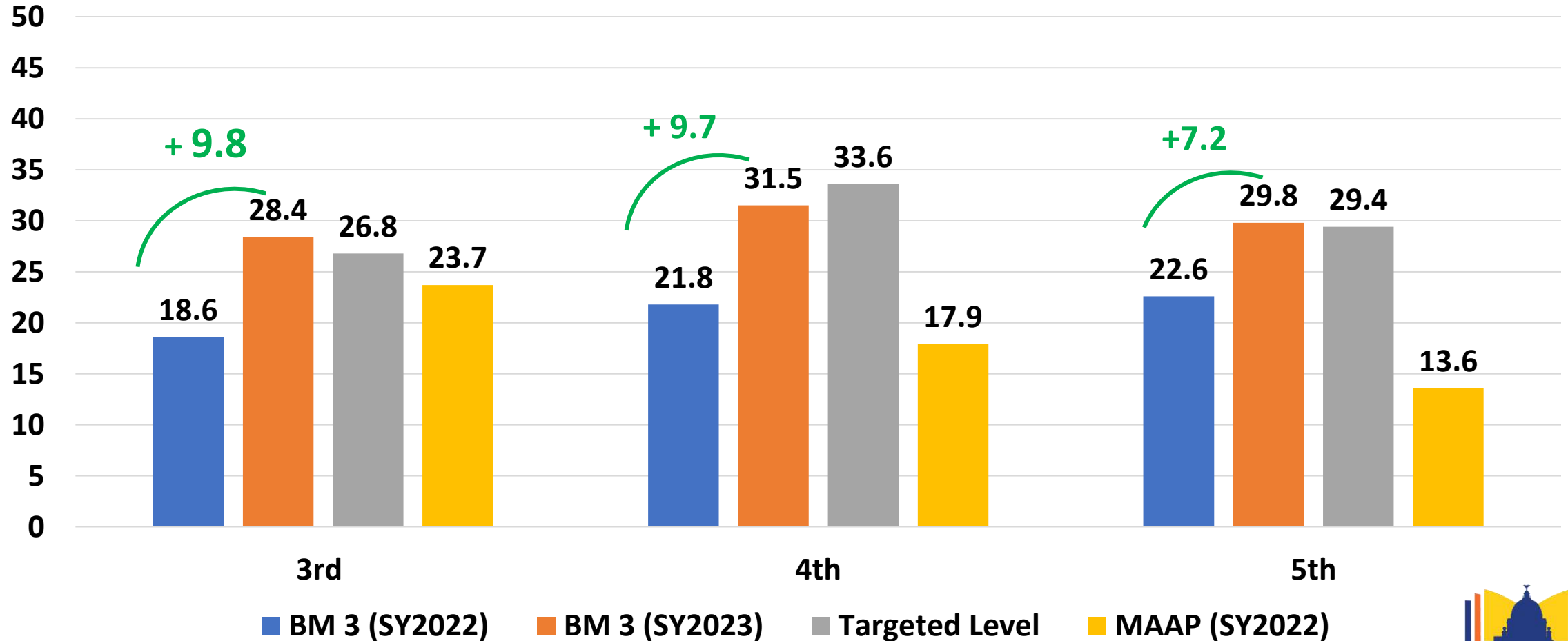




Proficiency By Grade Level

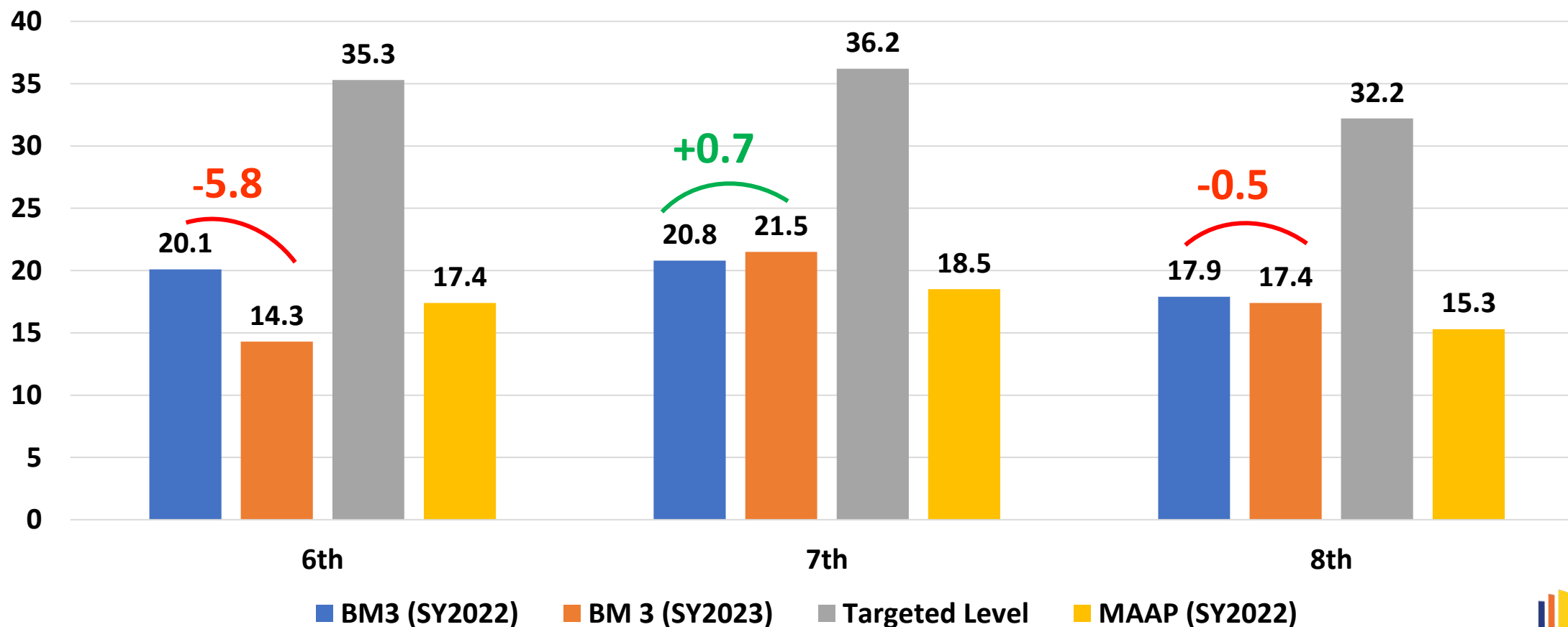

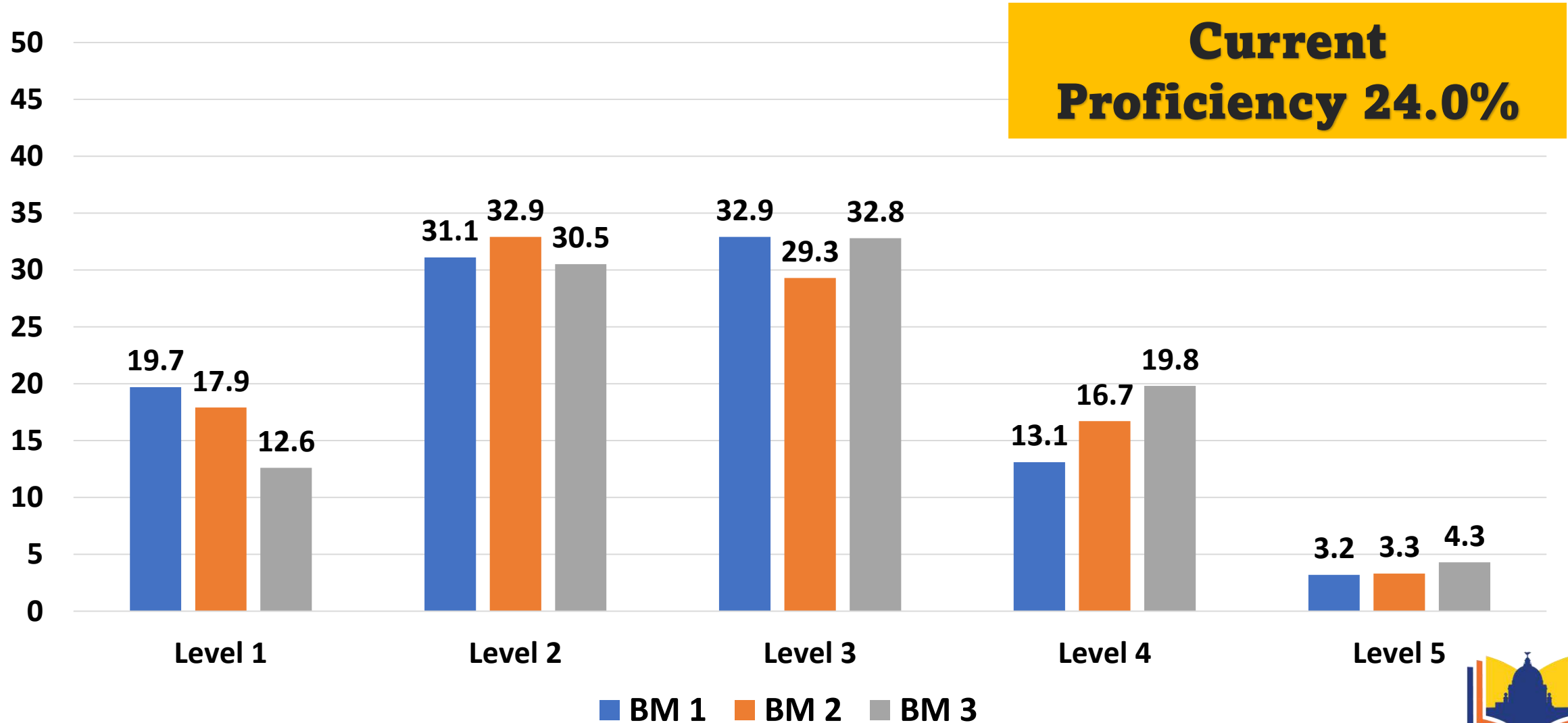


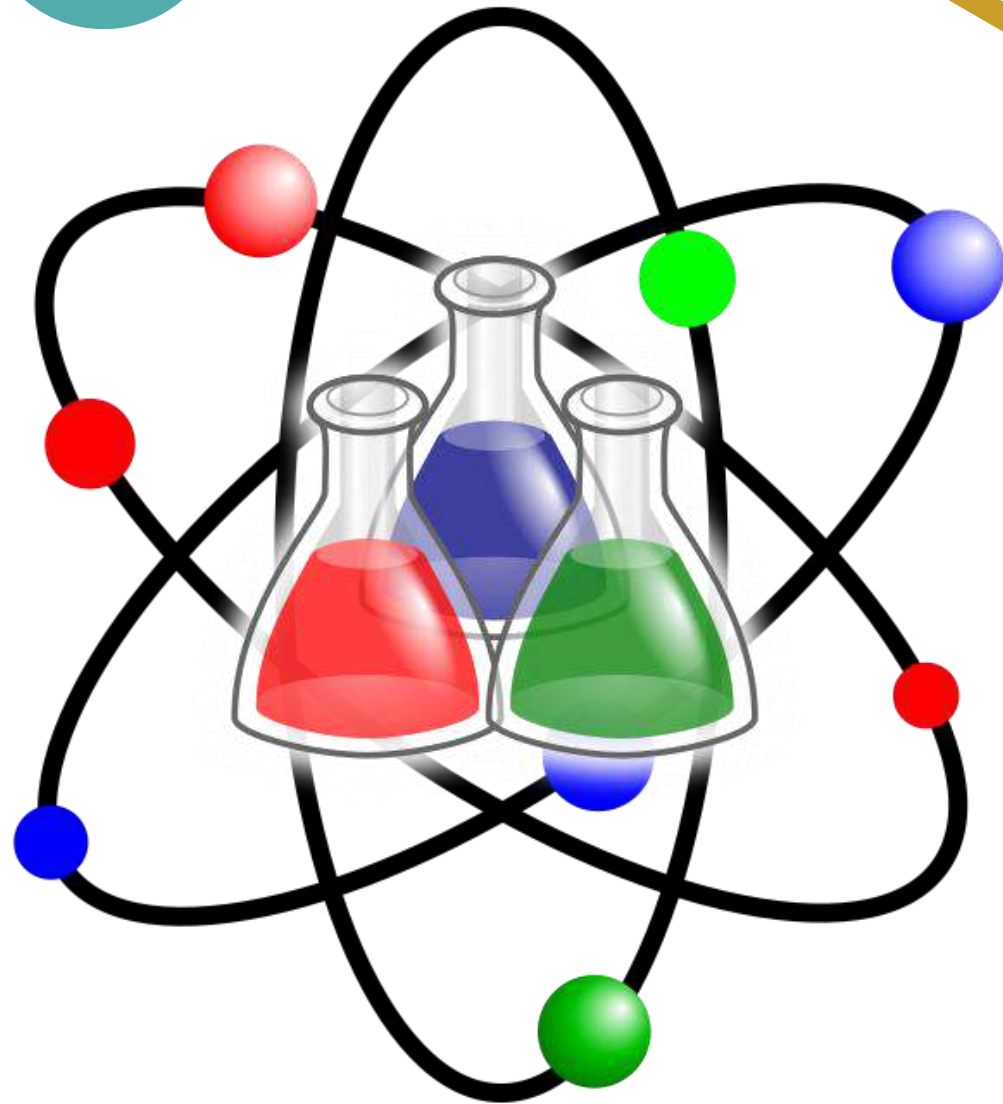


Algebra I Benchmark 3



Mathematics Performance Levels 1 – 5

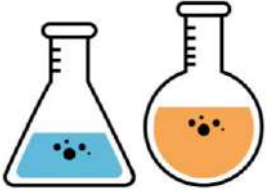




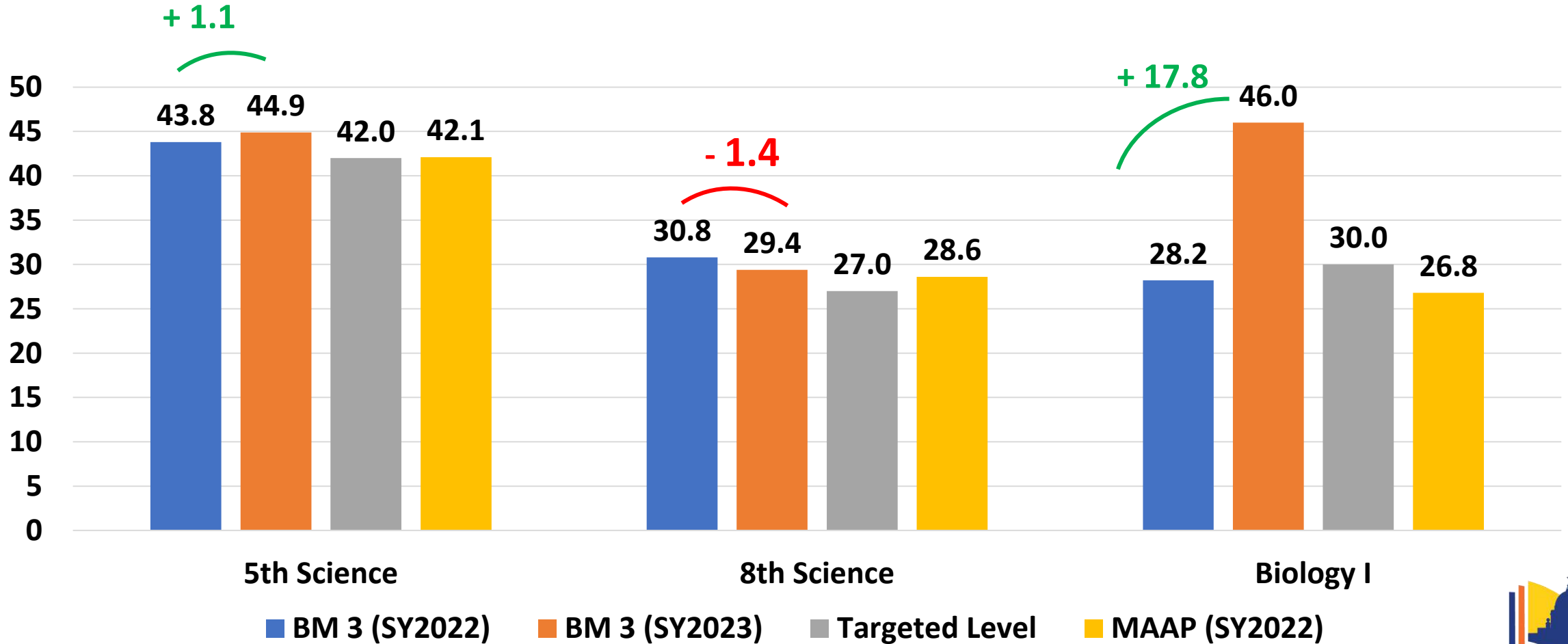

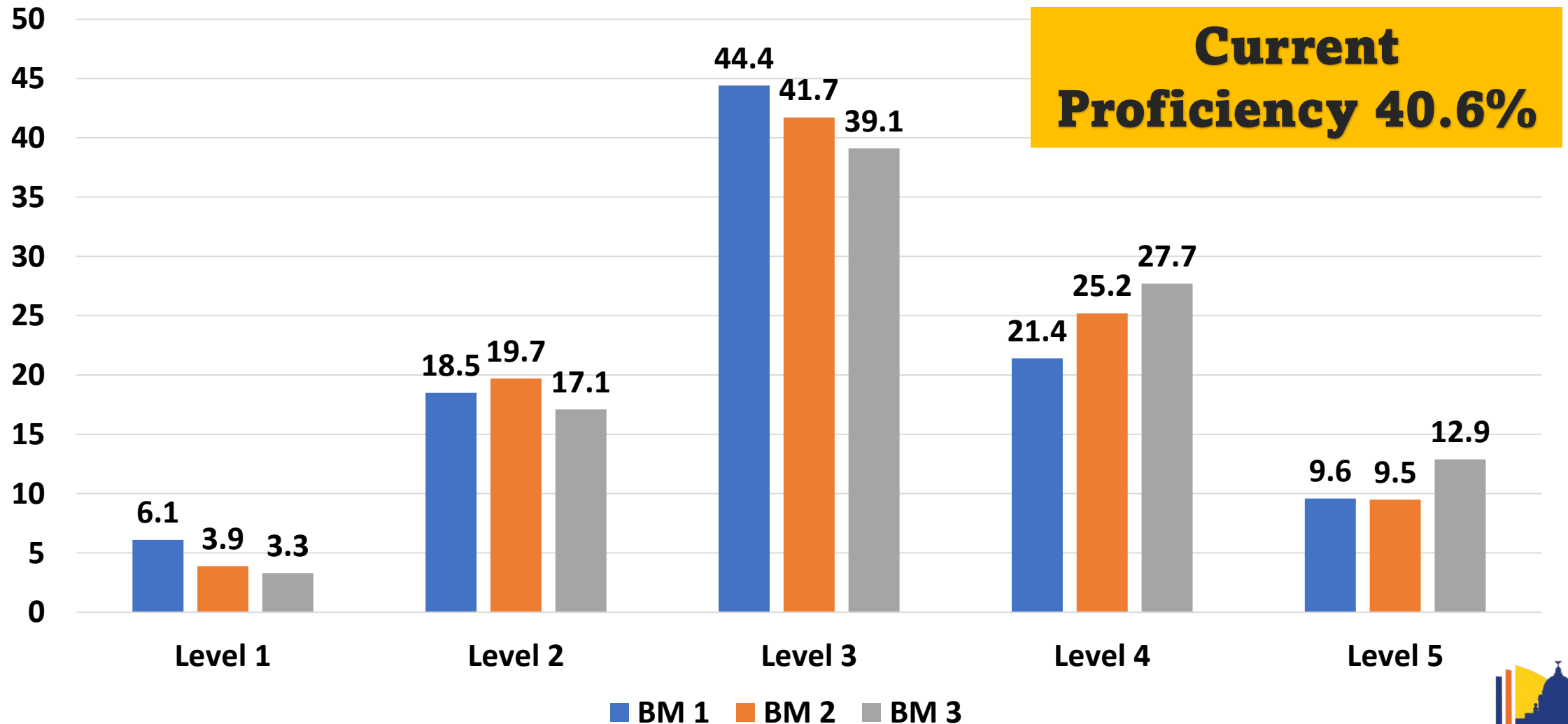

Science Performance Levels 1 – 5



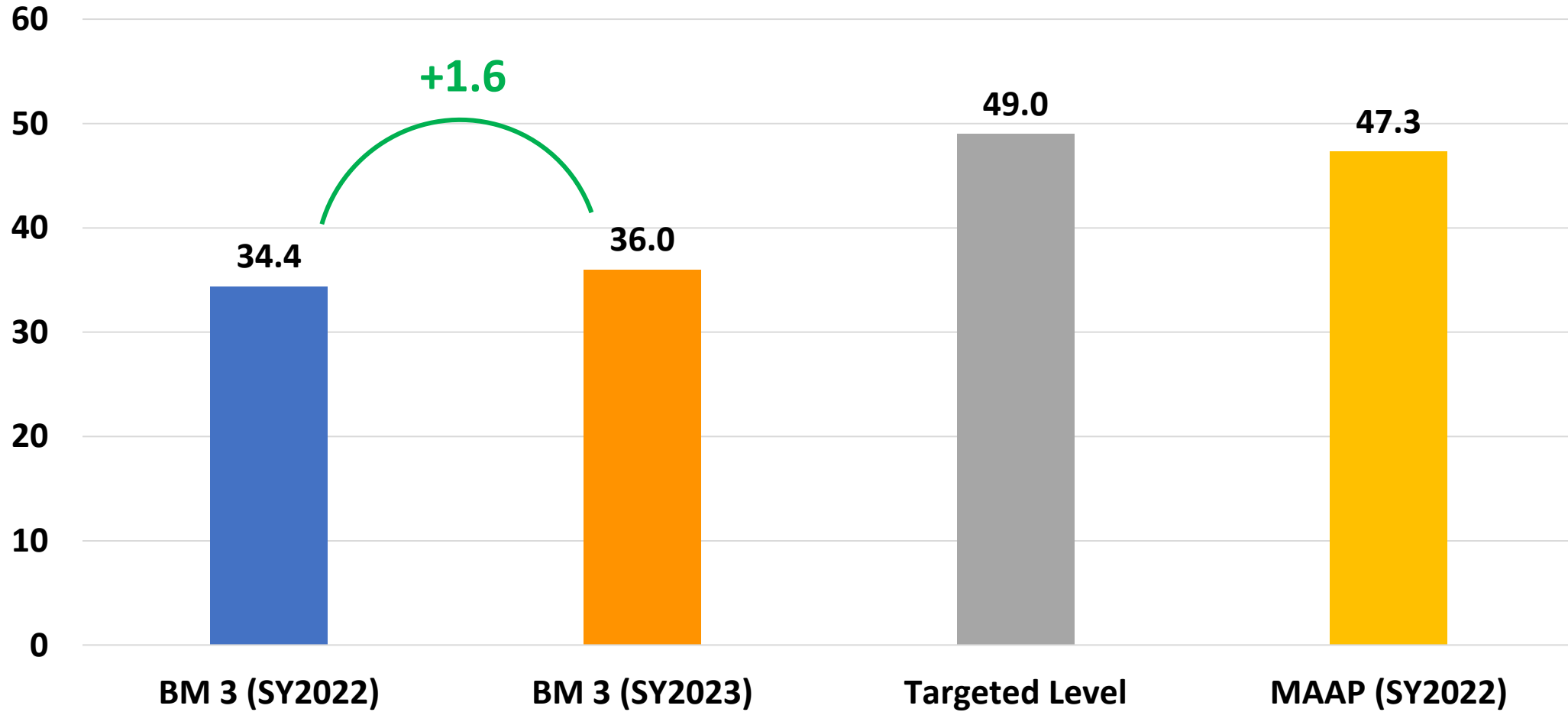


US History Data



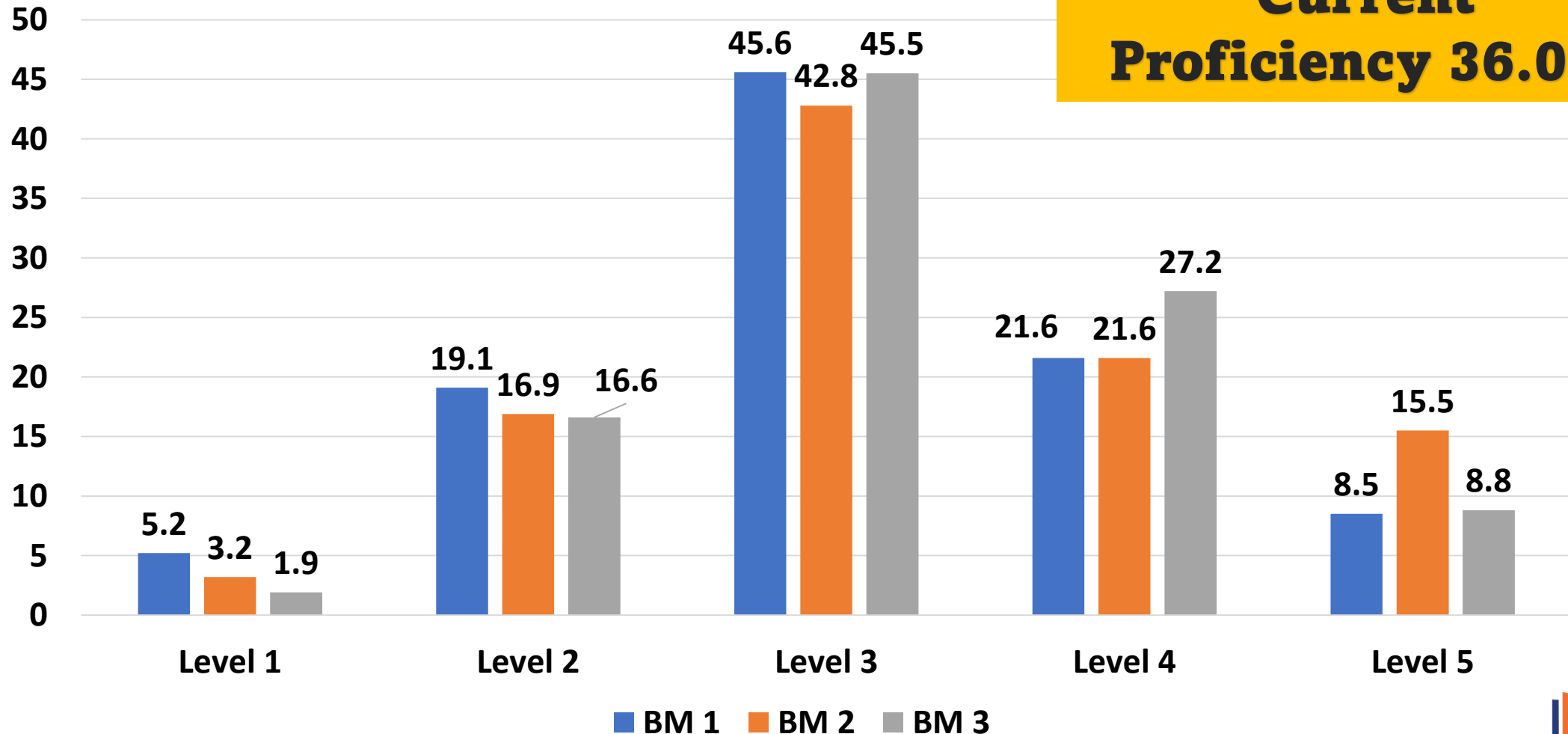


US History Benchmark 3

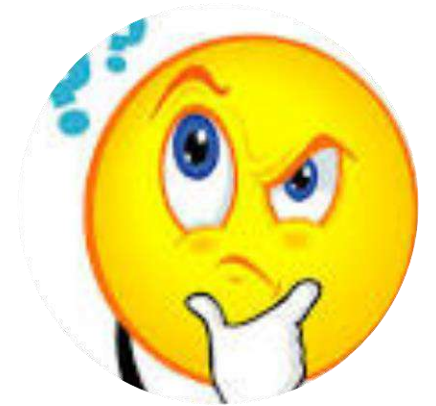


Road MAP to a “B” – Game Time

○ Effectiveness of School's Success Plans

- What is the frequency of push-in/pull out tutorials?
