Here are the six types of syllables.

CLOSED SYLLABLES

Ends with a consonant and the vowel makes a short sound

at

box

fab/ric

rab/bit

OPEN SYLLABLES

Ends with a vowel and makes a long vowel sound

go

hi

o/pen

ta/ble

VOWEL CONSONANT-E

Contains a long vowel consonant silent -e pattern

home

sale

con/fuse

rep/tile

R-CONTROLLED VOWEL

Contains a vowel followed by an r

tar

for

be/fore

cor/ner

VOWEL TEAM

Contains a vowel team or long vowel pattern that makes a long sound

mail

deep

tex/tile

end/game

CONSONANT -LE

End with a consonant and -le

lit/tle

cir/cle

mid/dle

gen/tle
