ABOUT CHEMISTRY

Chemistry A is the first trimester of a two trimester course. Students can expect to spend 1-2 hours of time outside of class per week. This time should include reading or reviewing the textbook, daily practice problems, book problems, lab reports, and studying for tests or quizzes. Course topics include measurement, kinetic theory, matter, atomic theory, naming compounds/writing formulas and solubility.

Learning Targets

Students will be provided learning targets throughout the units. Quizzes and tests will be broken down by learning targets.

MATERIALS that you are required to bring to class EVERY day

- Notebook
- Folder with 3 tabs or 3-ring binder
- Pencil
- Calculator

You also need to check out a Chemistry (Matter and change) textbook from the LMC that you keep where you will study.


COURSE EXPECTATIONS
