## **TASC Testing Schedule**

TASC REGISTRATION PROCESS: All students must be pre-registered and scheduled prior to the dates listed below. Students will receive an e-mail confirmation 3–5 days before the test date. If the session is full, students will receive additional dates to choose for testing. For students who are accepted into the testing session, their e-mails will not have the correct start times. Please complete the Fact Sheet for Testing Dates and Times and give a copy to students. This form requires students' signatures and date on which they signed the form. Also, the original of this form must be included in the TASC paperwork.

Teachers must turn in the original copies of the WV TASC Form and Appendix 2 or 2A with a copy of a photo ID attached. For the Garnet testing center, the Fact Sheet for Testing Dates and Times form must also be included. Because original copies are now required, all paperwork must be hand delivered to the Garnet Learning Center. Don and Benda have a crate in Joan's office for you to place the original paperwork. Please use the side entrance to the Learning Center on John Norman Street when dropping off paperwork.

A maximum of fifteen students will be tested each day of scheduled testing with priority given to students taking all parts of the TASC.

DAY OF TESTING: Students must bring their Federal/State-issued photo IDs. No exceptions.

Report to Room 105 at Garnet Career Center 15 minutes before testing begins and bring federal/state-issued photo ID.
