Practical Film Unit – Recreate a Scene in Psycho

Students are to recreate a scene from 'Psycho' directed by Alfred Hitchcock in 1960.

Students will work in groups of 6 students and they will do the following steps to recreate a scene from Psycho:

- 1. Choose an appropriate location(or multiple locations) that will work with what you are filming & assign production roles (director, actors screenwriter, storyboarder, camera ops, sound ops, editors)
- 2. The sequence may be altered for artistic/humorous effect, such as by using *parody, homage* or *pastiche* but it must feature 3 shots that match the original, or at least make obvious reference to it.
- 3. Storyboard the sequence
- 4. Have actors within the group learn the lines and blocking, and practice delivering the lines and performing them to camera.
- 5. Film the sequence with video camera and sound equipment
- 6. Edit the sequence with editing software such as Adobe Premiere or DaVinci Resolve. <u>All students will edit their</u> own films.
- 7. Export it to an MP4 and SUBMIT video on Compass Learning Task.

3. PRE-PRODUCTION: Storyboard your sequence using the attached Storyboard template attached > this must be completed BEFORE YOU START PRODUCTION



5.	PRODUCTION: Identify your location, which camera you will use and any audio equipment + BEGIN SHOOT (aim to complete shoot in 1-2 days)
6.	POST-PRODUCTION: Identify which video editing software is being used to edit sequence + complete the edit (aim for at 5 days max) + SUBMIT mp4 video file on Compass Learning Tasks.
