Course Description

The Teachers for Tomorrow program is an advanced level course designed to introduce students to a career in teaching and education. The primary elements of the curriculum components are the learner, the schools, the teacher, and teaching. The components are intentionally broad in scope and provide a great deal of flexibility based on the career interest of students. In addition to the fundamental curriculum components, all students are required to complete an internship outside the Teachers for Tomorrow classroom. Students have the opportunity to compete within SkillsUSA.
