

<b>Technology Lesson</b> <b>Internet Search Engines 11-15-2007</b> <b>Jody Kocer</b> <b>30 minute lesson</b>		
<b>Objective</b>	To understand the function of search engines and to be able to effectively narrow a search for specific information on the internet.	
<b>Standard</b>	5.1L.1.1 Produce relevant information using advanced internet search functions.	
<b>Anticipatory Set (Hook)</b>	Has anyone heard of a search engine? Has anyone heard of Google?	
<b>Teaching</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>input</b></li> <li>- <b>modeling</b></li> <li>- <b>check for understanding</b></li> </ul>	Using the computers, the students will go to the 5 search engines listed on the board. At each search engine, students will enter a teacher selected topic. Model how to add quotation marks around various words to narrow searches.	
<b>Guided Practice/Monitoring</b>	Monitor students as they enter various topics into the search engine. Point out how the number of articles found will decrease as the search is narrowed down.	
<b>Closure</b>	Ask students, "How can this knowledge of narrowing searches help you in school?"	
<b>Independent Practice</b>	Let students choose one topic of their own choosing and practice the search narrowing technique.
