

2018-19 TEST CORRECTION POLICY FOR AP STATS

Students may do test corrections to earn back half of the points they lost. Here are the guidelines:

IMPORTANT: I WILL “NOT” GRADE ANY TEST CORRECTION THAT ARE

- COMPLETED WITH MESSY AND DIFFICULT TO READ HANDWRITING. YOU CAN TYPE CORRECTIONS.
- DISORGANIZED AND DIFFICULT TO FOLLOW WORK. I’M NOT A CRYPTOLOGIST.

What: Tests ONLY! It does not apply to quizzes.

When: Must be handed in within 2 class periods following when the test was returned.

Why: To encourage students to learn concepts they did not understand in the assessment.

How: You must **PROVE TO ME WITHOUT A DOUBT** that you understand how to do the problem correctly.

* For every problem that you want to earn back half the points, you must do the following:

1. Corrections are to be attached to the test and are to be done on notebook (not spiral) paper.
2. Format: Corrections must include the following...
 - Clearly number the problem(s)
 - Skip lines between problems
3. Review your mistakes Label this “**REFLECT**.” Clearly describe in **2+ grammatically** correct sentences,
 - i. Explain what you did wrong in complete detail; **or**
 - ii. Explain why you were unable to do the problem and how you should have prepared to do this problem for the test.
4. For Free Response, completely redo the **ENTIRE** problem **with more detail** to prove to me you know how to answer this question and deserve to earn half your points back.
 - **Step 1** label **REFLECT**: (see #3 above); and then skip a line and provide the correction:
 - You must completely redo **ALL PARTS** (even the parts you got correct).
 - From the question, include all of the information needed to correctly do this problem (i.e. statistics, sketch graphs, description of the problem, etc.) **I should be able to understand this test correction without having to go back and read the question.**
 - Show **EVERY** step necessary to get the correct answer in a clear and neat manner.
5. Multiple Choice Problems
 - **Step 1** label **REFLECT**: (see #3 above); and then skip a line and provide the correction:
 - Correct this problem like a Free Response question. From the question, include all of the information needed to do this problem so I do not have to go back and **read the question.**
 - Show **EVERY** step **with more detail** to prove to me you know how to answer this question.
 - For vocabulary questions, write the correct answer in a grammatically correct paragraphs or bullets. You must cite the book location(s) you used.
 - **INTERNET: If you used the internet, cite the source, print the page and attach to the back of your test corrections.** Label this addendum **INTERNET**.

Remember this is an opportunity for you to improve your grade and I am expecting quality work!
