PSAT/NMSQT: CMS will provide the opportunity for all students in grade 11 to participate in the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) exam on *Tuesday, January 26, 2021*. Participation in this assessment provides an opportunity for students to qualify for scholarship money and gain valuable experience in preparation for the SAT or ACT exams. In preparation for test day, the district has created a "Student Intent to Take PSAT Survey" for all grade 11 students, to identify those who intend to come into the school building to participate in the PSAT/NMSQT exam. The survey will also allow them to identify if they need transportation. All grade 11 students are required to complete the intent survey by *Monday, December 14, 2020*.
