Chapter 10 Questions: Select quotations from the text that support your answers. 7. What do we learn about Tea Cake through the checkers situation?
8. Verigible is a dialectical offshoot of <i>veritable</i> (use the dictionary). What do you make of his name? Think of the other names in the text so far as well.
