Text structure is the way a text is arranged or organized.

Authors organize text in to make the information easier for a reader to <u>understand</u>.

Being aware of these organizational patterns will help you read with better understanding and write with more precision.

The text structure can change several times within one selection.

It can even change within one paragraph!





Service dogs are custom-trained to assist people who have illnesses or those with physical disabilities. Dogs are paired with a person in need of assistance with specific tasks. 

Service dog training follows three phases. <u>First</u>, the dog is taught to **heel.** This means the dog walks beside the trainer, not in front or behind. <u>Then</u> the dog is taught to *proof.* This requires training the dog to tune out distractions. <u>Finally</u>, the dog is taught **tasking**. This is teaching the dog the specific tasks they will be performing.







Service dogs and therapy dogs are both extensively trained to offer support in different ways. Service dogs are individually trained to perform specific tasks and do work that their handler can't do because of a disability. They are highly trained to perform tasks that will help their handler attain safety and independence. Therapy dogs also receive extensive training. However, their job is to provide psychological therapy to individuals other than their owners. These dogs have friendly, easy-going temperaments, and typically visit hospitals, schools, and nursing homes. Unlike service dogs, they are encouraged to interact with people.
