- Something to draw or paint with (crayons, colored pencils, and or paint)

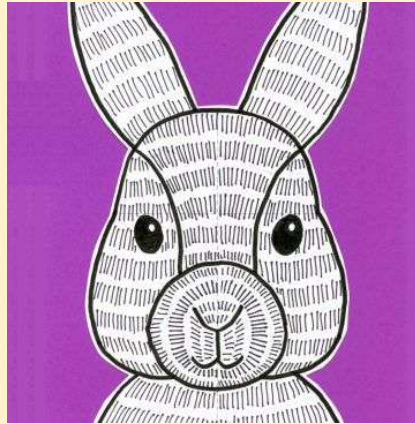


Soft Bunny

- Something to draw with (crayons or colored pencils)

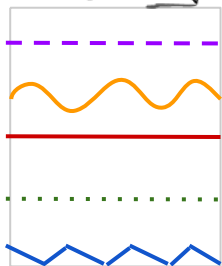




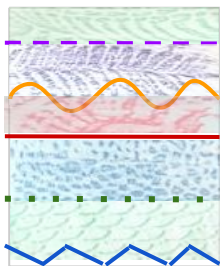
Texture Monster

Materials:

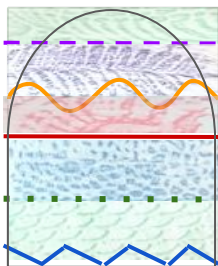
- Paper

- Something to draw or paint with (crayons, markers, colored pencils, paint)



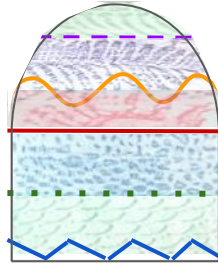
Draw 5 or 6 lines across your paper



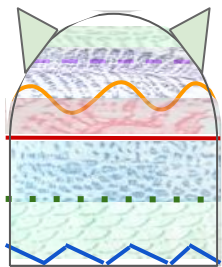
Fill in each section with a different texture rubbing



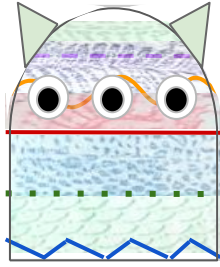
Draw a half circle at the top *use a bowl or plate if you need help!



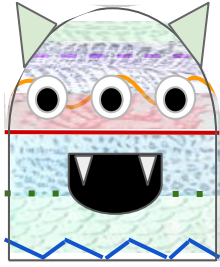
Cut along the line you drew. Save the corners :)



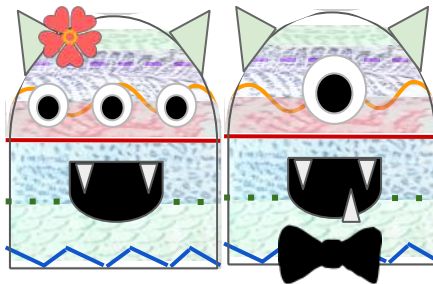
Stick the triangle shaped corners onto the back for ears



Draw or glue on some eyes (how many do you want?)



Give it a mouth with sharp triangle teeth!



Make it unique!

You can also add watercolor before adding my eye(s) and mouth!



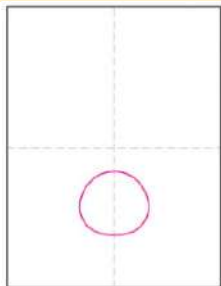
Texture Bunny

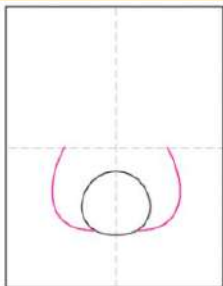


Materials:

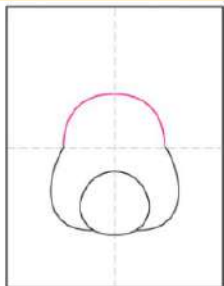
- paper
- Something to draw or paint with (crayons, markers, colored pencils, paint)



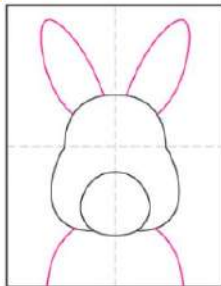
Draw a circle. Just below the middle of the paper.



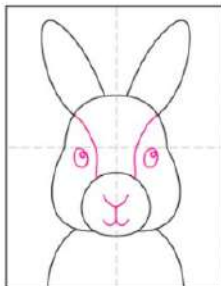
Make 2 "C" shaped curves up to the middle for cheeks.



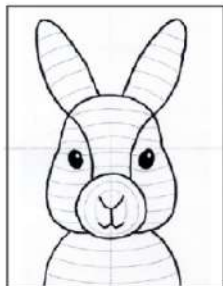
Make a rainbow shaped curve for his head.



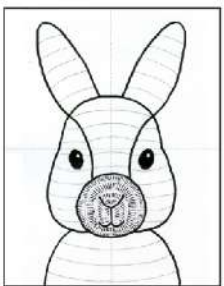
Add some big tall bunny ears and shoulders.



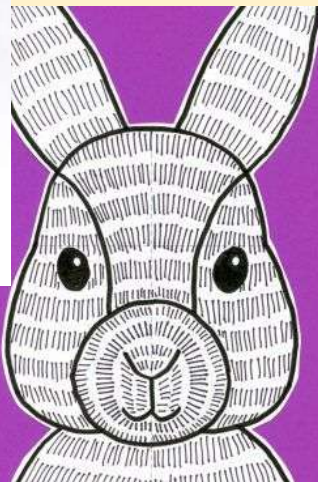
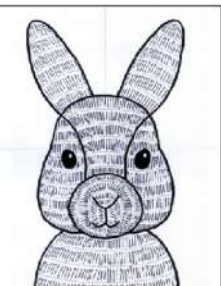
Draw in some eyes, a nose and mouth



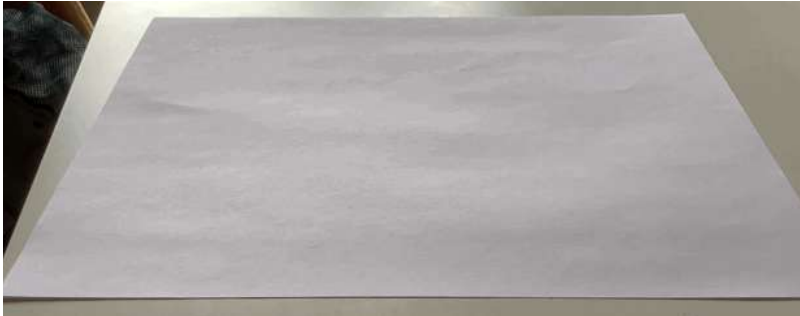
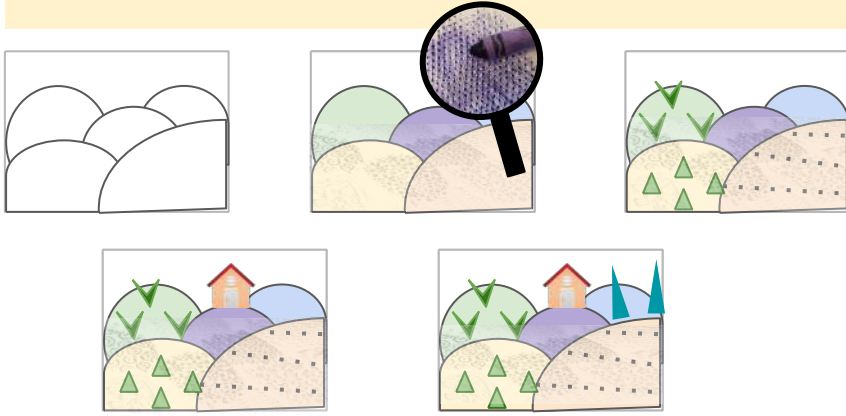
Lightly draw lines across the bunny



Carefully make straight fur lines between the light lines

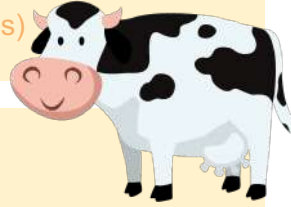


Bumpy Farm



Materials:

- paper
- Something to draw / make a rubbing with (crayons, colored pencils)



-Draw a hills using overlapping circles! *(you can use a plate, bowl, or something else round if you need help with your circles!)*

-Outline your hills in color.

-Create a **different rubbing to fill up each circle.** *(no white space)*

- Draw some plants for each hill
(flowers, greens, trees...)

-Put in a farmhouse
(Maybe a Fence)
