Come up with a theme for your race. Ex. Bridges, or statues of statesmen, or sport venues, etc.

- 1. You must use all 7 continents at least once.
- 2. Choose the sites you will have your teams meet at. Get the exact lat. & long. for the site as well as the continent, country and city. Think about museums, statues, buildings, parks, natural landmarks, rivers, bridges, churches, geological formations, theaters, etc. as meeting spots.
- 3. Fill out the chart below with the required information.
- 4. How will the teams get from place to place? Fly, walk, ride a bike, take a train, sled dogs????? The method of transportation must be possible between the area you are coming from and the one you are going to!
- 5. Locate and record the sites on your <u>map</u> <u>sheet</u>. Number them and then connect them in the order you plan for the contestants to go.
- 6. <u>Picture Sheet</u>: Cut and paste to a Google doc a picture of the site you selected for meeting. Google Earth has photos on it!! Label the <u>lat & long</u>, <u>site</u>, <u>city</u>, <u>and country</u> under each picture. Please label it (your last name, Amazing).
