Two-Way Conversation	Emphasis on Learning	Opportunities & Challenges
Like all good conversations, both talking & listening are keys to a successful conference.	Focus on how well the child is doing in schoolcelebrate your child's learning & development!	Teachers want your child to succeed—you'll very likely hear positive feedback & areas to improve.
