- Do some research, what is \$100 in 1929 worth today?



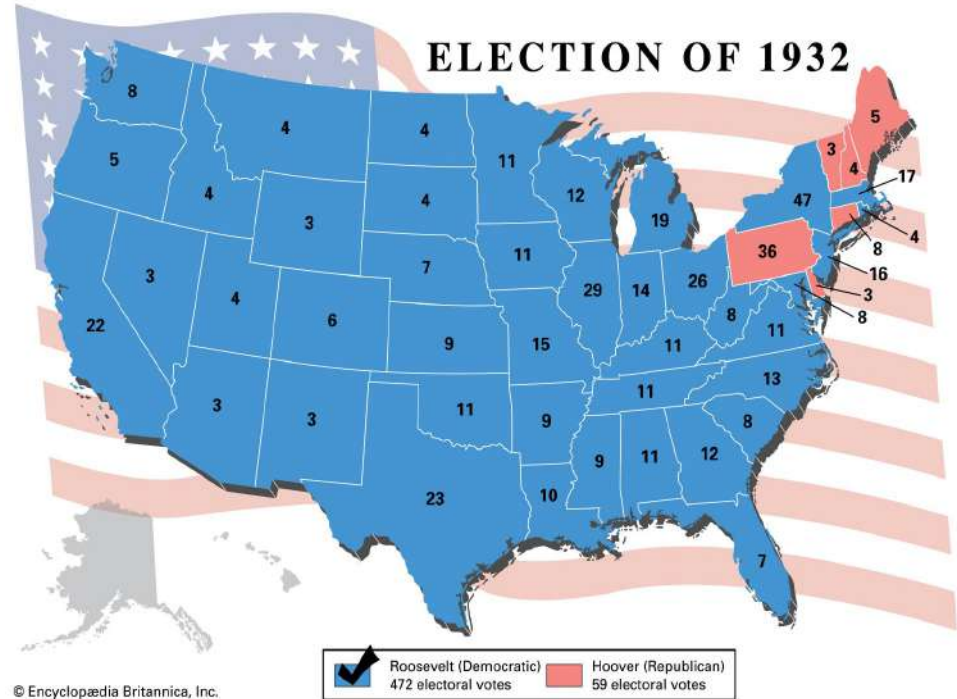
# 1928 Campaign
