

Dear Sun Path Parents,

It is hard to believe it is already Spring Break and we will be starting our final quarter of the 2014-15 school year. The next nine plus weeks should be a very busy and exciting time at Sun Path.

We will be administering both the MCA and MAP testing to our students during the months of April and May, starting with the week we get back from break. The MCA's are the state wide tests for students in grades 3 through 5. All the tests will be computer based. Teachers should be communicating with you the days of testing for their class.

In addition to the MCA and MAP testing, our students continue to work hard in the classroom, we continue with our music informances, and many grade levels have special events and field trips planned. We will be having our Track and Field Days in May. The PTO will also have their annual "Sun Path Academic Celebration" (SPAC) on April 30th . See the calendar on pages 3 & 4 for more information on upcoming activities for the 4th quarter. Our Sun Path Student Council has been very active this year and will be sponsoring a food drive the week of April 13th, look for more information to come home soon in Red Folders.

The Shakopee School District is holding a school referendum election on **May 5.** There are two ballot questions. The first to fund an addition to our current high school and improve interior and exterior facilities. The second question is a technology levy. In the Red Folders this week is a fact sheet about the referendum. If approved, the technology levy would help fund devices for students and staff, professional development in the use of technology, and support staff to help keep the technology working as intended. Because of this, it is difficult to honor parents' request for a certain teacher. We ask that you describe your child's needs and strengths, and not request a teacher.
