## The Planets by Gustav Holst

Gustav Holst composed a musical suite (think Nutcracker Suite) that is a set of movements related to the tit	le.
The seven movements represent seven planets:	

Mars - Venus - Mercury - Jupiter - Saturn - Uranus - Neptune

The entire suite may be conceived as a progression of life from its beginning (Mars) to its end (Neptune). We might give a role to each planet based on its astrological sign or character (you know, horoscope).

## Part 1

What role would YOU assign to the planet? Why?

Provide some adjectives and adverbs to describe the planet.

How would you draw the planet to match the role you have assigned?

Would your picture be of a person, an object, or an animal? Explain.

Which colors would you use?

B. If you were to set your planet to music, what instruments would you use?

What would the tempo (speed) and dynamics (volume) be?

Would the tempo, dynamics, and instruments stay the same, or change?

Would you include text or narration? Why?
